CONCEPT NOTE

Introduction

The teacher education system of a country has a pre-dominant responsible role in preparing teachers who are the best in professional knowledge, wisdom, attitudes & values, skills and competencies. Teachers in turn play a pivotal role in preparing future generations of global citizens through education.

Over the years, teacher education in India has undergone a paradigm shift towards becoming more pragmatic, evolutionary and inclusive. There is pronounced emphasis on teacher reflection in the present day teacher education curriculum. The focus is providing education that is experiential and deeply embedded in the diverse socio-cultural milieu of the country.

Education is no longer defined in terms of what a teacher will teach but rather in terms of what a student will be able to demonstrate. Immense importance is being given in schools to students for cooperative and collaborative learning, developing as well as demonstrating life skills, use of information technology, creative and innovative thinking.

Curriculum, pedagogy and assessment practices in teacher as well as school education are intricately associated. While new developments in teacher education have shaped the system for the better; there still exist several challenges in preparing quality teachers for the present and the future.

The draft National Education Policy (NEP) 2019 envisions to build a strong indigenous system of education which shall be able to transform India sustainably into an equitable and vibrant knowledge society. There is a strong advocacy in draft NEP 2019 to rigorously transform the present teacher education system into vibrant multidisciplinary institutions of higher education.
