Technology brings real life experiences in the classrooms, providing opportunities to learners to participate in complex cognitive tasks, expanding horizons for getting individualized feedback, enhancing interaction between teachers and learners and creating scope for teachers development. All of them deliberated on various aspects of ICT in education. They told about various courses like MOOCs, online portals like SWAYAM, Swayamprabha, ARPIT portal, MOODLES, EDMODO,

Google classroom etc. The aspects of copyright, plagiarism was also discussed. The resource persons also apprised the learners with the limitations that technology brings and multiform barriers. The FDP concluded with certificate distribution to all the participants on 24 Dec 2019.
