MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING ON PLACEMENT AND CO-OPERATION

This MoU, based on general dissensions & Arguments, is executed on 24 April 2023.

BETWEEN

ARMY INSTITUTE OF EDUCATION (hereinafter referred as "AIE"), through its principal Dr. Abhilasha Gautam at having its campus at M-1, Pocket P-5, Greater NOIDA, U.P, INDIA.

AND

KR MANGALAM WORLD SCHOOL, Chi-2, Greater Noida U.P. (hereinafter referred to as "KRMWS"), through its Principal Ms. Sonia Anil Verma at having at Plot No. F-2, Pocket P-5, Builder Area, Near AWHO Apartments, Chi II, Greater NOIDA, Uttar Pradesh 201301.

The Expressions "AIE" and "KRMWS" Shall mean and include their respective successions, legal representations and assignees.

PURPOSE

The purpose of this MoU is to foster collaboration between AIE & KRMWS. The aim is to establish a placement and academic link between the two institutions for mutual benefits and in a spirit of friendship and co-operation.

2. Scope and Aims of Cooperation

This MoU is for general purpose on the above mentioned scope and areas of cooperation-

- (a) To promote and enhances academic interest between AIE & KRMWS.
- (b) To provide placement opportunities at KRMWS for AIE students.
- (c) To promote research activities between the two institutions.
- (d) To promote student participation between the two institutions.
- (e) To conduct capacity building activities for mainstreaming teaching and learning practices.
- (f) To permit AIE students for teaching practice at KRMWS.

3. AIE and KRMWS are collaborating in order to provide Internship and Placement opportunities to students enrolled at AIE.

Both parties here to agree as follows:

- Decisions regarding the placement of students (such as number of students, dates of placement, frequency of visit, duration, timings etc.) will be taken mutually.
- KRMWS shall provide sufficient oversight of the program to ensure that it meets
 the needs of the students. AIE students will get exposure of working under the
 KRMWS school.
- 3. An orientation will be given to trainees by KRMWS before placement in classrooms.
- 4. During their placement, AIE students will observe rules and regulations and execute responsibilities assigned by the KRMWS team (such as Taking classes, prepare necessary teaching learning material, provide group or individual attention to persons with special needs at KRMWS, volunteer in events and functions).
- Both the parties will collaborate in organizing faculty and student enrichment activities of both the organization with aim of continuous professional development and knowledge sharing.
- Issuance of Certificate and gratitude letters or appreciation letters to resource persons for conducting enrichment programs from either party will be on mutual concern.
- KRMWS will provide attendance details and appreciation certificate to the interns.
 If reqd. feedback will be also provided to AIE.
- The selection, recruitment and offered salary to AIE students for any post (PRT/TGT/PGT/Special Educator) will be according to the rules and regulations of KRMWS, Greater NOIDA.
- Army Institute of Education, Greater NOIDA will allow its students to attend the various events/ Seminar/ placement sessions conducted by KRMWS.
- This collaboration shall be effective for a period of three years from 24 April 2023 to 23 April 2026. Renewal of this MoU and continuation of the Program will be subject to each Party signing a renewal agreement.
- 11. There will be no financial and legal liability on part of either party.
- 12. This collaboration may be modified at any time by written consent of both Parties and may be terminated by either party at any time by giving at least thirty days' written notice.

Limitation of liability: Neither party shall be liable for any special, indirect, incidental, punitive, contingent nor consequential loss or damages suffered out of or in connection with the aforesaid MoU whether as a result of a breach of this MoU or otherwise.

Dispute Resolution:

- 1. This is a non-binding Memorandum of Understanding ("MoU"). The parties recognize that a bona fide dispute as to certain matters may from time to time arise during the term of this MOU, which relates to either Party's rights or obligations hereunder. In the event of
- The occurrence of such dispute, either Party may, by written notice to other Party, have such dispute referred jointly to the authorized representatives of the Parties, or their successors or counterparts, for an amicable resolution by good faith negotiations within 15 days after such notice is received in respect of such dispute.
