SOP FOR AWARDING OF EDUCATIONAL SCHOLARSHIPS TO STUDENTS OF ARMY PROFESSIONAL COLLEGES UNDER WESTERN COMD

Introduction

- 1. Army Welfare Society Education Society was registered in April 1983. The organization expanded and has grown to 136 Army Public Schools and 12 Professional Colleges, as on dt.
- 2. HQ Western Comd is running five Army Professional Colleges under its jurisdiction. These colleges are providing 'Quality Education at Affordable Cost' since inception. Awards of Excellence had been introduced by AWES in Army run Professional Colleges/Institutions to serve as a source of inspiration and motivation for the students to work hard and excel in their fields.

Aim

3. Aim of this SOP is to lay down the guidelines for implementation of 'Awards of Excellence' in the form of Cash Awards in Army run Professional Colleges/Institutions at Comd/College Mgt level.

Scope & Justification

- 4. At present the 'Awards of Excellence' are being given by HQ AWES for the final year students of all professional colleges, vide their SOP issued letter No B/45840/Trophy/AWES dt 19 Apr 2010. No such awards are being given to students of other batches (except final year).
- 5. To achieve a high level of inspiration and motivation for the students for other batches, it has been recommended by BQA to introduce new 'Awards of Excellence' in the form of of Cash Awards at Comd/College Mgt level.

Awards and Modalities

- Based on the proposal and recommendations of the environment, it has been proposed that similar cash awards should also be applicable to all other students (less final year students, which are being granted by HQ AWES). Since final year students are being granted Awards of Excellence' by HQ AWES, therefore, the students of other batches/Years should be granted awards by Comd/College Mgt level. All Instts have agreed to grant of cash awards to I, II, III and IV yr students (as applicable as per course duration, less final year students). Amount of cash award will be shared 50% each by Comd HQ (CWF) and College Mgt respectively.
- 7. To have uniformity in the cash awards, the recommended cash awards for I, II & III yr students securing 1st, 2nd and 3rd posn are as under:-

(a) 1st posn - Rs 20,000/-.

(b) 2nd posn - Rs 15,000/-.

(c) 3rd posn - Rs 10,000/-.

While preparing the final result for selection of eligible students for grant of 1st, 2nd & 3rd posn award for various Courses being run by all five Colleges, the fwg minimum percentage of marks has been specified and in case the specified percentage is not achieved by a student, no award will be granted :-

Implementation

12. Upon declaration of results, Instt will work out and list out the winners. Awards list, duly approved by Instt Mgt, will be fwd to this HQ for approval of BOA. After receipt of approval, full amount of award will be awarded and presented to the winner by the Instt Mgt. Thereafter, share of Comd HQ will be requisitioned by each Instt and will be reimbursed to the Instt from Comd Welfare Fund (CWF). The above Awards of Excellence shall be implemented wef Academic Session 2021-22 to be awarded at the end of the Academic Session 2021-22 (upon declaration of results).

Conclusion

13. The Awards of Excellence have been introduced in the Army Professional Colleges under Western Comd with effect from academic years 2021-22. The award would serve as a source of inspiration for the students to work hard and excel in their fields and to motivate them to join the Armed Forces.
