NCTE VISIT

On May 8, 2023, the Army Institute of Education (AIE) went for an educational visit to the National Council for Teacher Education (NCTE). The visit aimed to provide insight into the coordinated development of teacher education nationwide and the regulations maintaining standards in the field. The faculty and students were divided into three groups: Group-A with 40 students and 3 teachers, and Groups B and C with 19 students and 3 teachers each.

Upon arriving at NCTE at 10:30 am, accompanied by the Dr. Abhilasha Gautam principal AIE, the groups were escorted to their respective conference halls by NCTE representatives. After the arrival of Ms. Kesang Yangzom Sherpa, IRS member secretary of NCTE, the lamp lighting by the officials and staff members of AIE and the NCTE held and the informative session started. Key discussions encompassed NCTE's ongoing projects, such as transforming B.Ed. programs into four-year courses accessible after 10+2 studies, and projects like NPST and NMM, aimed at fostering parameters for effective teaching and learning. Online

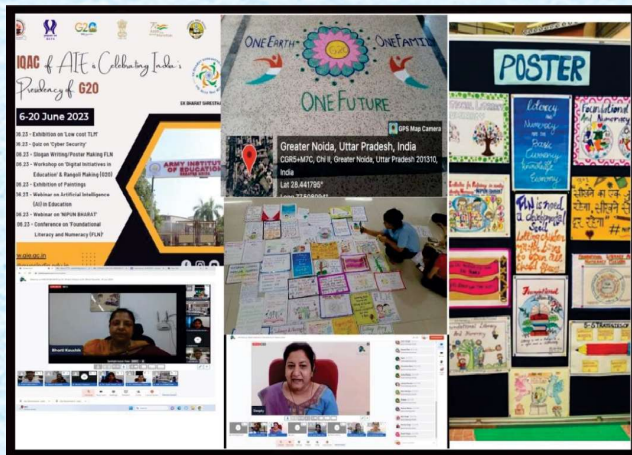

In the academic year 2022-23, 62 students were enrolled, with 52 interested in placement opportunities. As of August 15, 49 students were successfully placed, with 2 still in the process. The highest offered salary is 35,000 per month, including accommodation, equivalent to an annual package of 4,20,000. The minimum salary is 25,000 per month, resulting in an annual package of 3,00,000. The average salary achieved thus far is 27,816 per month, or 3,33,792 per annum.

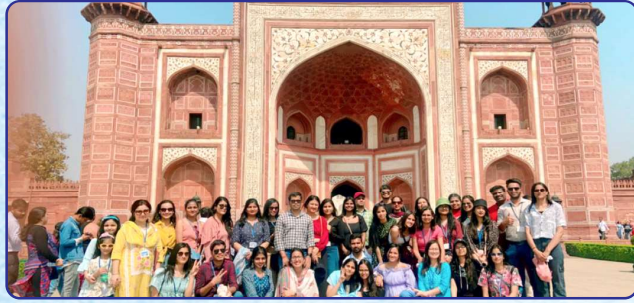
