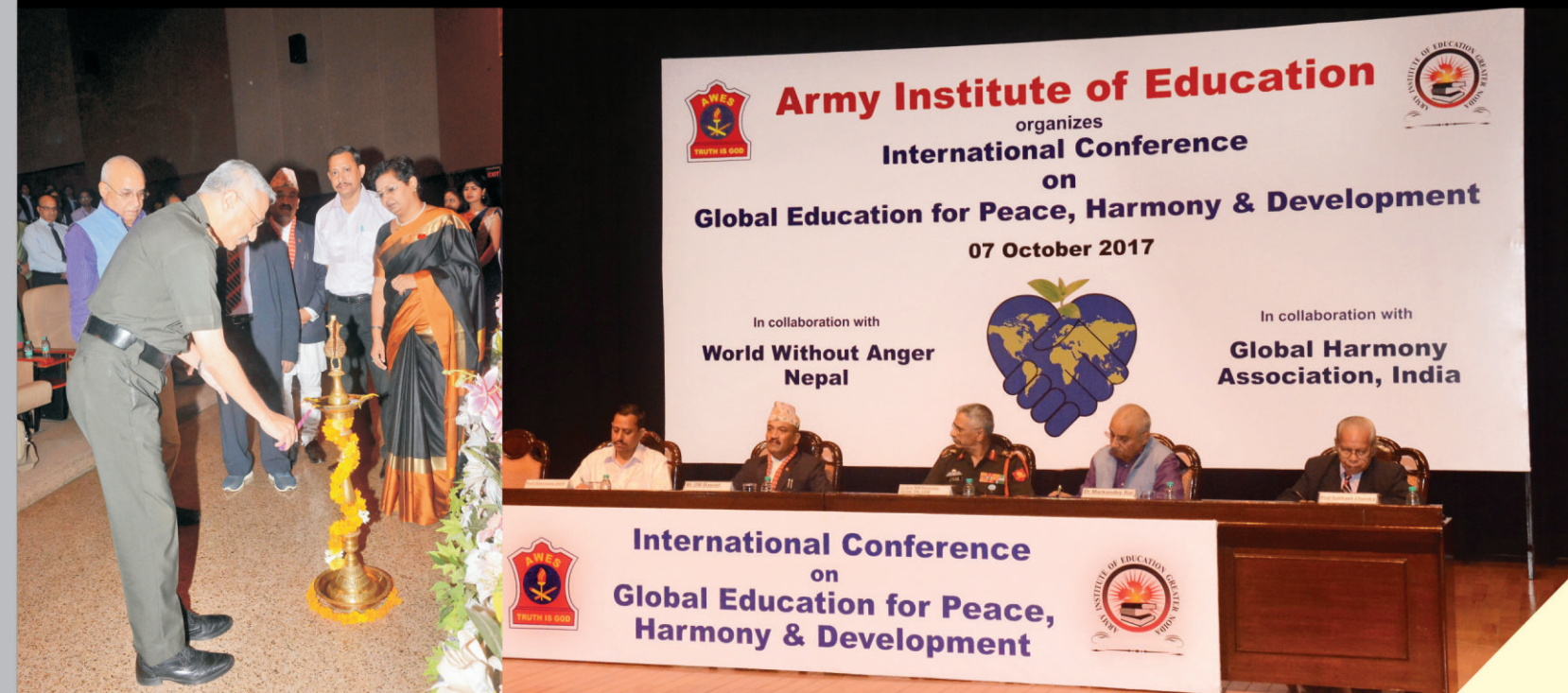
Technical Session I was based on two themes "Global Education and Universal Peace Values for Global
