- ❖ **Policy Implementation**: The session on legal provisions equipped participants with knowledge to advocate for and implement inclusive education policies.


- ❖ Community Engagement: Understanding community-based rehabilitation and services fostered a sense of community engagement among educators and stakeholders.
- Improved Inclusive Practices: The knowledge shared in the webinar is expected to positively impact classroom practices, making education more accessible to diverse learners.


Conclusion:


