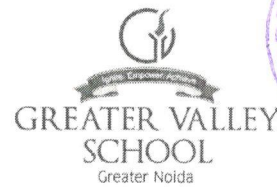
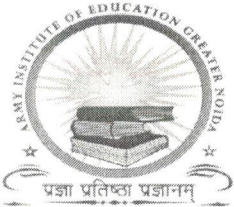

MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING ON ACADEMIC EXCHANGE AND CO-OPERATION

This MoU is signed and executed on this 1st of September 2021 at Greater NOIDA

BETWEEN

ARMY INSTITUTE OF EDUCATION (hereinafter referred as "AIE") having its campus at M-1, Pocket P-5, Sector CHI-2, Greater NOIDA, UP- 201310

AND

SAAMARTH (Special Education Wing of Greater Valley School, Greater NOIDA) having its location at HS- 20, P- 7, Sector - Omega II, District- GB Nagar, UP- 201310

The Expressions "AIE" and SAAMARTH" shall mean and include their respective successions, legal representations and assignees.

AIE and 'SAAMARTH' are collaborating for academic association enabling students enrolled in B.Ed. & B.Ed. Special Education (Learning Disability) programme at AIE to observe, intern and implement inclusive teaching practices at SAAMARTH for children with special needs. The present MoU will foster collaboration between AIE Greater NOIDA and 'SAAMARTH', Greater Valley School, Greater NOIDA for education, research and training.

Both parties herein agree as follows:

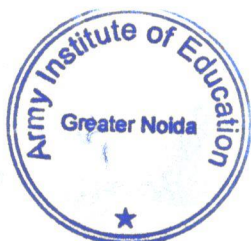
1. Decisions regarding the engagement of AIE student-teachers for observation and internship at SAAMARTH (such as number of students, dates of school placement, frequency of visit, duration, timings etc.) will be taken mutually.
2. SAAMARTH shall provide sufficient oversight of the inclusive programme to ensure that the AIE interns meet the needs of the students with and without special needs. AIE students will get exposure of working in an inclusive school set up, get an insight into working of an inclusive school and develop requisite knowledge and experience of working in a multi-disciplinary setting.
3. An orientation will be given to AIE interns by SAAMARTH before placement in classrooms for observation and internship with students with special needs.

4. During their placement, AIE students will observe rules and regulations and execute responsibilities assigned by SAAMARTH (such as prepare necessary teaching learning material, provide group or individual attention to learners with special needs and learning disability at SAAMARTH, volunteer in events and functions).
5. AIE students will write reports and prepare Individualized Education Programme (IEP), case studies as per the curriculum needs of the teacher education & special education programme of AIE mandated by the affiliating University. A copy of the reports and case studies will be shared with SAAMARTH, if desired.
6. In order to respect the privacy and confidentiality, contact details of the families will not be shared. If required meeting with parents will be arranged by SAAMARTH at their school premises.
7. SAAMARTH will provide with appropriate certification upon successful completion of school observation, engagement and internship.
8. There will be no financial liability on part of either party.
9. This agreement shall be effective for a period of three years ^{1st} September 2021 to ^{1st} September 2024. Renewal of this agreement and continuation of the Program will be subject to each Party signing a renewal agreement.
10. This agreement may be modified at any time by written consent of both Parties and may be terminated by either parties at any time by giving at least thirty days written notice.

MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING
ON ACADEMIC EXCHANGE AND CO-OPERATION

This MOU, based on general discussion & Agreements, is executed on this
01 day of Sep 2017 at Greater Noida

BETWEEN

SAAMARTH (Special Wing of Greater Valley School) having its location at HS- 20, P-7, Sector – Omega II, Dist- GB Nagar, UP - 201310 Near Gautam Buddha University Greater Noida, UP - 201310

AND

ARMY INSTITUTE OF EDUCATION (hereinafter referred as "AIE") having its campus at M-1, Pocket P-5, Sector CHI, Greater NOIDA, UP, INDIA.

The Expressions "SAAMARTH" and "AIE" Shall mean and include their respective successions, legal representations and assignees.

1. PURPOSE

The purpose of this MOU is to foster collaboration between SAAMARTH & AIE. The aim is to establish an academic link between the two institutions for mutual benefits in a spirit of friendship and co-operation.

2. OBJECTIVES

The objectives of the MOU are-

- (a) To promote and enhances academic interest between SAAMARTH & AIE.
- (b) To provide advice for implementation of quality of education at AIE.
- (c) To encourage students of AIE to come for placement at SAMARTH.
- (d) To promote research activities between the two institutions.

3. AREAS OF CO-OPERATION

The two parties agree to explore the possibility and promote the collaboration in the following areas to further the common interests of the two parties.

- (a) Exchange of teaching and research staff.
- (b) Organization of just academic activities such as seminar, lectures, conferences, project and Faculty Development Programme (FDP).
- (c) Conduct of personality development programmes at AIE for enhancement of skills in respect of faculty, staff and students.
- (d) Exchange of academic material and other information of common interest.
- (e) Provide guidance to establish video satellite link and assistance in development of E-Classrooms, lab curriculum, establishment of research labs, library etc.
- (f) To facilitate training and placement of students of AIE at SAAMARTH.

4. PROPOSED MODES OF COLLABORATION:

DSA and AIE propose to collaborate through the following:

- (a) Co-operation and promotion of education and training in areas of mutual interest.
- (b) Any other appropriate mode of interaction agreed upon between SAAMARTH and AIE.

Senior staff from SAAMARTH & AIE will communicate and meet regularly in order to finalize & promote the details of collaboration.

5. RELATIONSHIP BETWEEN THE PARTIES

The relationship between the parties may be in the nature of strategic alliance and nothing contained in this MOU shall be construed so as to constitute a partnership between the Parties or so as to constitute either Party as the agent of other. Both Parties carry their own responsibilities without any recourse to other party.

6. OPERATION OF THE AGREEMENT

- (a) This MOU shall become effective when signed by the authorized representatives of both the parties.
- (b) Any amendment or addition to the MOU must be made in writing and signed by the authorized representative of both the parties.
- (c) Both the parties agree to arrange the meeting of Joint Expert Committee for carrying out the details of MOU to finalize the areas of mutual interest, placement for various programs.

7. USE OF NAMES, LOGOS, MARKETING AND PUBLICITY

Neither party shall use the name or logo, or any variation thereof, of the other without first obtaining the consent from the other party.

8. DURATION OF MOU

This MOU, unless extended by mutual written consent of the *institutes*, shall expire in THREE years after the effective date specified in the opening paragraph. However, on review, the MOU shall be extended for another TWO years by mutual consent.

9. COORDINATORS

Both Institutes will designate persons who will have responsibilities for co-ordination and implementation of this agreement.

10. TERMINATION

This MOU can be terminated by either party due to breach of any covenants hereof by the other, giving three (03) months notice to the defaulting Party.

Notwithstanding the above, termination shall not prejudice any obligation that has arisen prior to the date of effective termination between the parties and/or obligation of either party to any other party.

11. SIGNED In DUPLICATE

This MOU is executed in duplicate with each copy being an official version and having equal legal validity. By signing below, the *institutes*, acting by their duly authorized officers, have caused this Memorandum of Understanding to be executed, effective as of the day and year first above written.
