Teacher Development Plan

In a constantly developing environment, the role of technology is increasing in every sector and now it is becoming an integral part of our education system as well. Gurushala is now bringing self-paced, interactive and free to use online courses.

Relevance

To resolve this and give an understanding of the classroom challenges and their possible solutions the courses have been broadly categorised into three themes for them.

1. Innovating conventional methods
2. Blending ICT with Pedagogy
3. Creating 21st-century classrooms

Development Plan

1. Innovating conventional methods

There are certain methods which are being used in our class from ages but with the change in surroundings, we have to be in rhythm with the trends and hence need to keep innovating our traditional methods.

Theme	Course	Description
Innovating conventional methods	Student Engagement	The course talks about different techniques which can be used by the teachers for engaging students in the learning process. It shows the implementation of these in the classroom as well. The course has the potential of enhancing the Critical thinking, Creativity and Mentoring skills, which are essential if a teacher wants to keep the students engaged in the classroom.
	Revision Strategies	The course talks about how a teacher can help students master the art of revision to deal with the problem of retaining information for the long term. The modules include various activities and techniques catering to the different aspects that are essential while revising simultaneously acting as an aid to develop creativity and

		critical thinking among the teacher as well as students through group interactions, asking questions and making distinctions and connections in their learning.
	Assessment and Evaluation	This course talks about Assessment; Evaluation; its methods and strategies and creation. It focuses on how to assess knowledge and skills together. The skill that the teacher will inculcate is that of analysis, critical thinking, and observation through this course.

2. Blending ICT with Pedagogy

Technology is an imperative part of the present day's education needs to be used in our classroom to make it more engaging for the students. A vast variety of content is available on the internet but it is very crucial to be able to choose and customize the information you want to deliver to your students. The idea here is to develop the understanding and impart the necessary skills which allow teachers and educators to curate, create and formulate diverse ideas to implement in the class.

Theme	Course	Description
Blending ICT with Pedagogy	Emerging Teaching Strategies	Emerging teaching strategies help a teacher to plan classes in a way that can complete the target course in time without leaving any child unlearned. These are some strategies that teachers can use to plan their lessons, deliver them, keep up with the progress of their children and assess them. Teachers will develop their creativity, observation and communication skills with this course.
	Tools for Content Creation, Customization and Curation	The course will revolve around techniques or usage of the ICT in creating contents for the students thereby enhancing the learning process. The web materials are huge in number, but it is the teacher who through who decides what is more helpful in the class. The skills that the teacher will add through this course are adaptability for technology, creativity through content presentations and high impact on the learning of children.
	Pedagogy of Mathematics	Mathematics is one of the subjects which is very closely related to our real-life and hence, provides a large number of opportunities to students. Thereupon, method and means of integrating the learning of mathematics with real-life examples are important. Keeping the need of 21st-century learners in mind the course is developed to cater to various topics and concepts of mathematics at the upper primary level. At the end of the course, the teacher will develop certain skills like creative thinking and problem-solving.

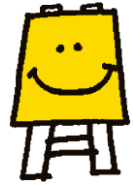
3. Creating 21st-century classrooms

Theme	Course	Description
Creating 21st-century classrooms	Classroom Management	Classroom management is a course for teachers and schools to create and maintain appropriate behaviour of students in classroom settings. Classroom management is one of the foremost skills a teacher must acquire right after knowledge of her subject and oratory skills. The teacher will acquire skills like decision making, team building, problem-solving and communication.
	Curriculum to Contemporary world	The course on Curriculum to Contemporary as the name suggests bridges a gap between the topics taught and its real-life significance. The teacher will be able to develop the skills of fostering creativity in her conduct of teaching a class, bring about critical thinking among the children and make them capable individuals who can tackle real-life problems through these curriculum-based projects.
	Social-emotional environment learning for	Social-emotional environment for learning aims at helping teachers to focus on the social and emotional wellbeing of a child. There is a lot of pressure on children with changing social norms especially young adolescent children. It is a course that provides a foundation for safe and positive learning methods that can be used by teachers to cater to the individual needs of children in a class.
