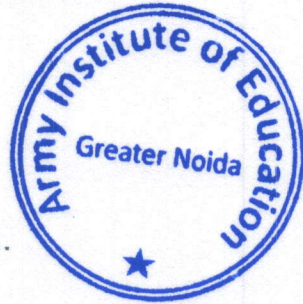

## MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING ON ACADEMIC EXCHANGE AND CO-OPERATION

This MoU is signed and executed on this SIXTH day of August 2021 at Greater NOIDA

BETWEEN

**ARMY INSTITUTE OF EDUCATION** (hereinafter referred as "AIE") having its campus at M-1, Pocket P-5, Sector CHI-2, Greater NOIDA, UP- 201310

AND

**CORNERSTONE INDIA FOUNDATION** having its location at Plot No. 11, Knowledge Park-I, Greater NOIDA, UP – 201310.

The Expressions "AIE" and "Cornerstone India Foundation" shall mean and include their respective successions, legal representations and assignees.

AIE and Cornerstone India Foundation are collaborating for academic association enabling students enrolled in B.Ed. & B.Ed. Special Education (Learning Disability) programme at AIE to observe, intern and implement inclusive teaching practices at Cornerstone India Foundation for children with special needs. The present MoU will foster Academic Exchange & Cooperation between AIE and Cornerstone India Foundation in providing Education, Research and Training in the areas of Special Education, Inclusive Education, Cognitive Behaviour Therapy and Counseling.

Both parties herein agree as follows:

1. Decisions regarding the engagement of AIE student-teachers for observation and internship at Cornerstone India Foundation (such as number of students, dates of school placement, frequency of visit, duration, timings etc.) will be taken mutually. Generally, 10 student-teachers of AIE shall be placed for observation and internship at Cornerstone India Foundation.
2. Cornerstone India Foundation shall provide sufficient oversight of the inclusive and special education programmes to ensure that the AIE interns meet the needs of the students with special needs. AIE students will get exposure of observing, interning and securing placements at Cornerstone India Foundation.

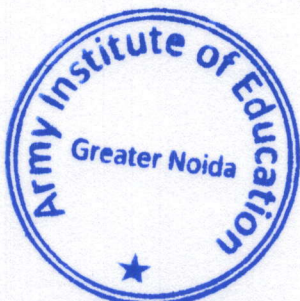

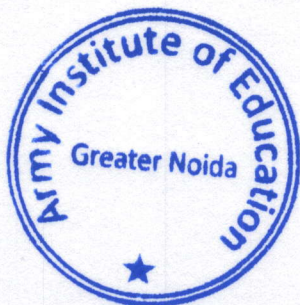
3. An orientation will be given to AIE interns by Cornerstone India Foundation before placement in learning environment of children with special needs.
4. During their placement, AIE students will observe rules and regulations and execute responsibilities assigned by Cornerstone India Foundation (such as prepare necessary teaching learning material, provide group or individual attention to learners with special needs at Cornerstone India Foundation, volunteer in events and functions and undertake research activities).
5. AIE students will write reports and prepare Individualized Education Programme (IEP), case studies as per the curriculum needs of special education programme of AIE mandated by the affiliating University. A copy of the reports and case studies will be shared with Cornerstone India Foundation, if desired.
6. In order to respect the privacy and confidentiality, contact details of the families will not be shared. If required meeting with parents will be arranged by Cornerstone India Foundation at their School and Therapeutic Centre premises.
7. Cornerstone India Foundation will provide with appropriate certification upon successful completion of observation, engagement and internship to AIE students.
8. The faculty of AIE & Cornerstone India Foundation will collaborate for workshops, training & certification in short term courses and conduct research. There will be no financial liability on part of either party.
9. For programmes organized with fee for stakeholders besides AIE & Cornerstone India Foundation staff and students, income, if any (above operational expenses, logistics etc) will be shared in 60:40 ratio between Party 1 (main organizer) and Party 2.
10. This agreement shall be effective for a period of three years 06 August 2021 to 05 August 2024. Renewal of this agreement and continuation of the Program will be subject to each Party signing a renewal agreement.


