


MINUTES OF THE MEETING HELD ON 31 Jan 2022

IQAC meeting was held on 31 Jan 2022 at 10:00 AM in the Conference Hall. The Chairperson, IQAC welcomed all the members for the twenty second IQAC meet and briefed about the actions taken report on the previous meeting by highlighting on the progress of reconstituted committees and clubs and also apprised about the implementation of Academic Calendar. Agenda points discussed are as under:

1. Planning for National Seminar- The topic for National Seminar, 'Inclusive Education for Sustainable Development: from Idea to Action' was shared and the proposed date 21 Feb 2022 was also communicated to all the members. Ms Meeta Bandula, Principal Jay Pee Public School, suggested that a subtheme on Assisted Technology which can help teach students with special needs, must be included. Ms Vanda Sharma, Director, MBCN, also supported the same. Dr Upasana Singh, Director, Human Touch Foundation, suggested that a sub theme on value education and Gender sensitization must also be there as these topics are losing their importance with passage of time and their impact on society must be revoked. - 2.
