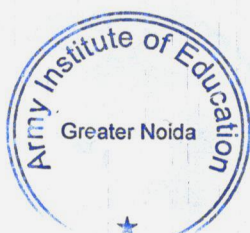


Institutional Distinctiveness Session 2017-18

I. Value Based Learning
