### THE INSTITUTE..

Army Institute of Education was established in August 2003 with the aim of providing pre service teacher education facility to the dependants of Army personnel. The Institute functions under the aegis of Army Welfare Education Society (AWES), which is managing 246 pre-primary schools and 133 Army schools and 12 Army professional institutes situated at different locations in the country. AIE is affiliated to Guru Gobind Singh Indraprastha University (GGSIPU), Delhi and is recognised by the National Council for Teacher Education (NCTE) for its B.Ed. programme. It offers a one year regular B.Ed. Degree course for an annual intake of 100 students. Eligibility is graduation and admission is based on the merit obtained in a combined written admission test (C-WAT) conducted under the aegis of AWES every year in Apr/May. The institute provides excellent hostel facilities to both boys and girls respectively. The institute is accommodated in brand new building with state of the art facilities.
