ORIENTATION TO 'DEVELOPMENT OF PROFESSIONAL COMPETENCIES AMONG TEACHERS' CONDUCTED BY CENTA, BANGALORE

Army Institute of Education organized an orientation to 'Development of Professional Competencies among Teachers' on Friday, 07 September 2018 at 1500 Hours. It was conducted by Ms Deepika Narang, Regional Lead – North Centre for Teacher Accreditation (CENTA). Centre for Teacher Accreditation (CENTA), Bangalore was founded in 2014 with an aim to empower teachers and catalyze teacher professional development through its CENTA certification that will connect outstanding teachers and teacher candidates to great opportunities. 170 students of B.Ed. Batch 2017-19 and 2018-20 attended the orientation programme.





The programme started with brief introduction of the resource person by Ms Nikita and Ms Tehnaaz, student-teachers of B.Ed. batch 2018-20. They also apprised the audience about the session.

Dr. Tania Gupta, Principal AIE, felicitated the Resource Person with a token of appreciation. Ms Deepika Narang addressed the students and explained about inception, vision and mission of CENTA. She oriented students to CENTA Certification and Micro-Credentials. The aim was to deeply assess the varied aspects of excellence in teaching and recognize outstanding scholars and support professional development of teachers, by providing participants with a detailed view of their performance in different competencies.

Ms. Deepika Narang deliberated at length about Teaching Professionals' Olympiad TPO 2018, a unique Annual National Competition to reward, recognize and celebrate teachers and aspiring teachers. It assesses subject expertise, content development & planning, student assessment and professional competencies & classroom communication.

Ms. Narang administered a multiple choice test in Mathematics, English & Science to asses Professional Competencies among teachers. Students of B.Ed. Batch 2017-19 and Batch 2018-20 appeared in the test in one teaching subject from their pedagogy. It was half an hour duration test and the result will be declared within 4-5 days. On the basis of their performance in the test, students will be able to avail scholarship in CENTA Certification and Micro-Credentials. Ms. Tehnaaz proposed vote of thanks to the Resource Person.
