## **Guidelines for Authors**

## 1) Review Process

Eduspectra: AlE Interdisciplinary Journal of Research and Education shall not accept or publish manuscripts in its journal without prior peer review. There shall be a review process of manuscripts by one or more independent referees who are conversant in the pertinent subject area. The editor evaluates the recommendation and notifies the author of the manuscript status. The manuscript may be:

- Accepted for publication as it is
- Accepted for publication with minor changes, with no re-review necessary.
- Accepted for publication after substantial revision and additional review
- Rejected

The comments of the anonymous reviewers will be forwarded to the authors for further revision in the manuscript.

- Length: Research papers, articles/critical reviews should be within 4000 to 6000 words; reviews of books and other educational materials should be 1000-1500 words.
- Abstract: A concise and factual abstract of 150-200 words is required. The abstract should state briefly the purpose of the research, the principal results and major conclusions.
- 4) **Keywords:** After the abstract authors must provide a maximum of 5 keywords.
- 5) Article Structure: The main research paper should include Introduction, Review; Objectives; Hypotheses, Methodology, Analysis, Results and Discussion, References, Appendix. Conceptual/reflective papers should have at least three sections: i) Background/Introduction; ii) Main section with subsections; and iii) Discussions/ Implications.

- 6) Style: Manuscript should be written in English. Font: Times New Roman, Text in font size 12 and Headings in font size 14, double spaced, 1" margin all round.
- References: References as per latest Publication Manual of the <u>American</u> <u>Psychological Association</u> (APA) 6<sup>th</sup> edition.
- 8) **Tables and Figures:** Tables and Figures should be numbered consecutively by Arabic numerals (Table 1, Figure 1, etc.)
- 9) Authors' name and affiliation: All the identification details of the authors including complete name, professional affiliation (specifying the city and country), institute's name, mobile number and e-mail addresses must be provided. Brief professional biographies (50-80 words) should also be attached.
- 10) Submission of two hard copies and soft copy is mandatory. Softcopy should contain full text of the paper in MS word not in PDF, including notes, reference, tables, charts and maps in the given format.
