PARTICIPATION IN NATIONAL WORKSHOP

A National workshop on **WRITING AND PUBLISHING A RESEARCH PAPER** was organized by VIDYAWATI MUKUNDLAL GIRLS COLLEGE, GHAZIABAD on 15-16 Feb 2019. The workshop intended to provide a common platform for researchers, academicians and eminent educationists from the field of education to share their experiences and deliberate upon the significance of writing and publishing a research paper. The workshop was Inaugurated by auspicious lamp lighting ceremony by chief guest Dr. Amerendera Pani Deputy Director and I/C Research Division, Association of Indian universities, New Delhi.

The two-day national workshop was comprised of six technical sessions. In the first technical session the resource person was Prof. Nishi Sethi, Associate Director Training, Haryana university Hisar. In her key note address to the gathering she presented her views on **TYPES OF**

Technical session II and III were chaired by Professor Rekha Aggarwal, School of Education, Central University of South Bihar and Dr. Rajesh Singh, Deputy Librarian Delhi University. They

addressed the gathering on literature review with specific focus on meta-analysis and Writing references (Impact Factor, h-Index, Scopus Index, Pub Med, API).

Their address was consisted of the following major points

- Review of related literature
- Systematic Review
- Meta-Analysis
- Research Matrices
- Types of Citation Data
- Types of Journals

On the second day of the National workshop the Fourth Technical session was chaired by Dr. R.C. Sharma, Professor of Instructional Design, Ambedkar University, Delhi. Dr. Sharma enlightened the gathering regarding the issues related to plagiarism and how to deal with it. The important aspects of his keynote address were as follows:

- Why do students plagiarize?
- Collusion/ collaboration
- Low confidence in reference skills
- Committee on publication ethics
- Types of plagiarism

The last two technical sessions, which were addressed by Professor Sangita Saini, Faculty of home sciences, Dayalbagh Educational Institute, AGRA and Professor Aejaz Masih, HOD Education, Jamia Millia Islamia, Jamia Nagar, New Delhi. Both the Resource persons delivered a talk on Identifying an appropriate journal and possible causes of paper rejection along with Drafting of Research Paper and its online Submission. The key issues which were raised during the presentation were as follows:

- Why the rejection of research paper happens?
- How to select an appropriate journal for your paper to be published?
- The topics which a specific journal publishes
- The journal's audience
- The reputation of the journal
- Your personal requirements
- About journal publishing process
- Things to be done before and after submission of a journal
- Responding to referees reporters
- Rules for getting a paper published

Four student-teachers of Army Institute of Education participated in the national workshop along with Dr Tania Gupta, Principal AIE & Ms. Pratibha Garg, Assistant Professor AIE.

Mr. Satish Kumar, Ms. Jyoti Mishra, Ms. Garima Singh and Ms. Julee Begum as participants. All the four student teachers had learned many things by participating in this two-day national workshop. The six technical sessions were very informatory for all those who have attended the workshop.
