## AIE OBSERVES SWACHHTA PAKHWADA FROM 01-15 AUG 2019

Cleanliness is most important for physical well-being and a healthy environment. It has bearing on public and personal hygiene. It is essential for everyone to learn about cleanliness, hygiene, sanitation and the various diseases that are caused due to poor hygienic conditions. Seeing the importance of cleanliness, Governement of India has initiated observing Swachh Bharat Abhiyan (SBA) or Swachh Bharat Mission (SBM), which is a nation-wide campaign in India for the period 2014 to 2019 that aims to clean up the streets, roads and infrastructure of India's cities, towns, and rural areas. The objectives of Swachh Bharat include eliminating open defecation through the construction of household-owned and community-owned toilets and establishing an accountable mechanism of monitoring toilet use. Run by the Government of India, the mission aims to achieve an "open-defecation free" (ODF) India by 2nd October 2019, the 150th anniversary of the birth of Mahatma Gandhi, by constructing 90 million toilets in rural India

Army Institute of Education supported the cause by observing Swachhta Pakhwada from 01-15 Aug 2019, as per guidelines received by State NSS Office, under Ministry of Youth Affairs and Sports, Government of India. Special Morning Assembly was conducted on few days, where students focused on cleanliness and its importance.
