

Intercollegiate Debate Competition

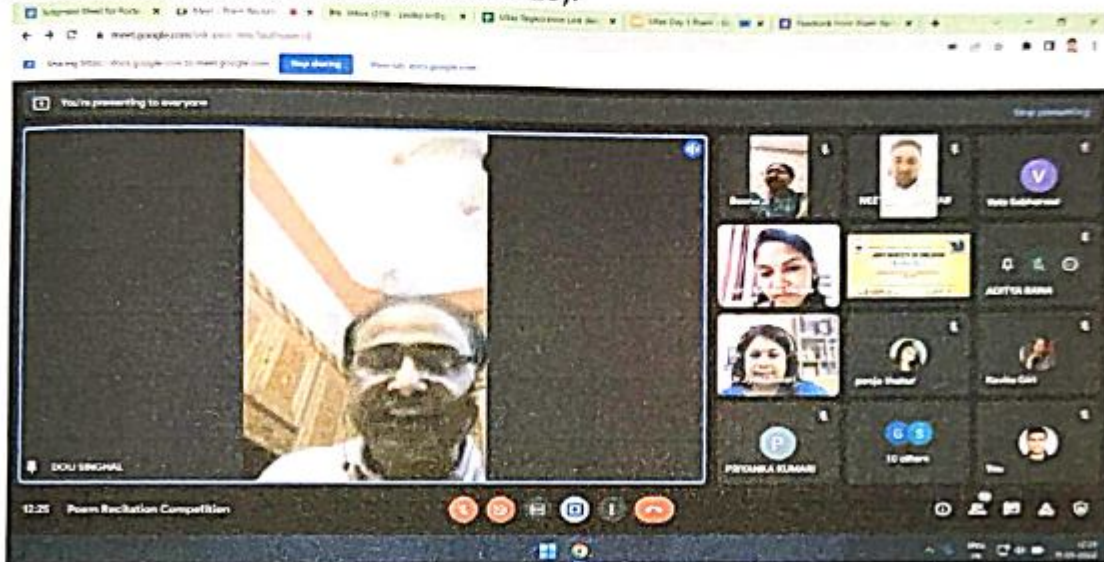

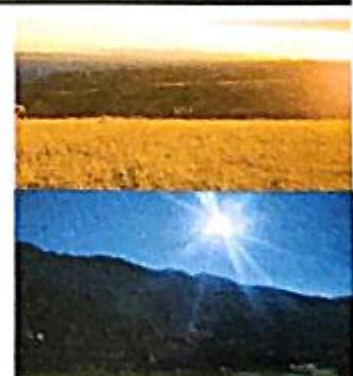

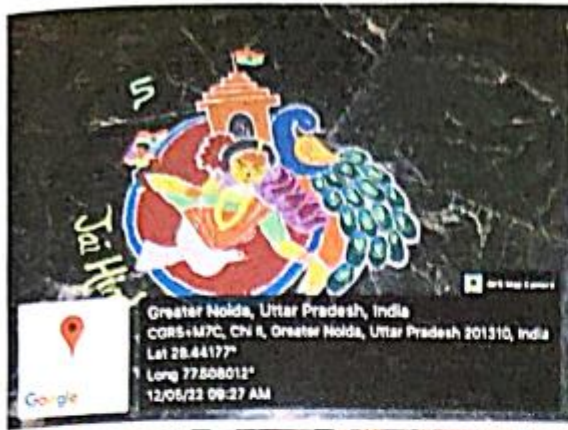

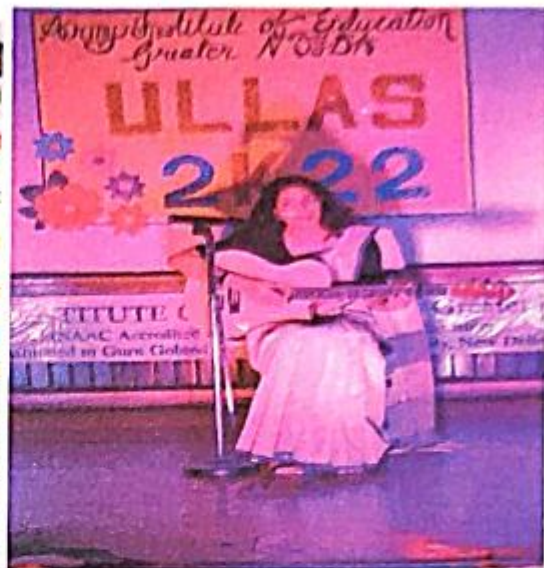
The rules and regulations for the competition were:

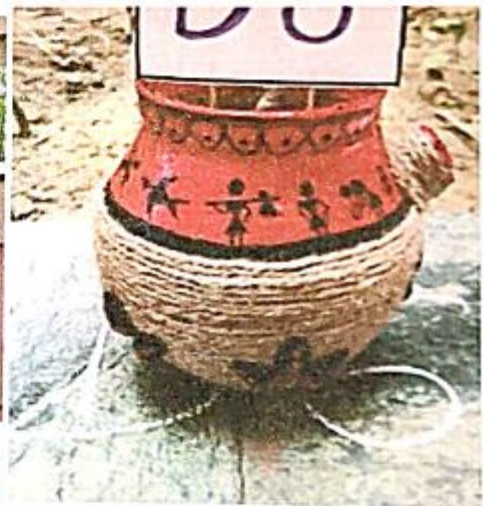

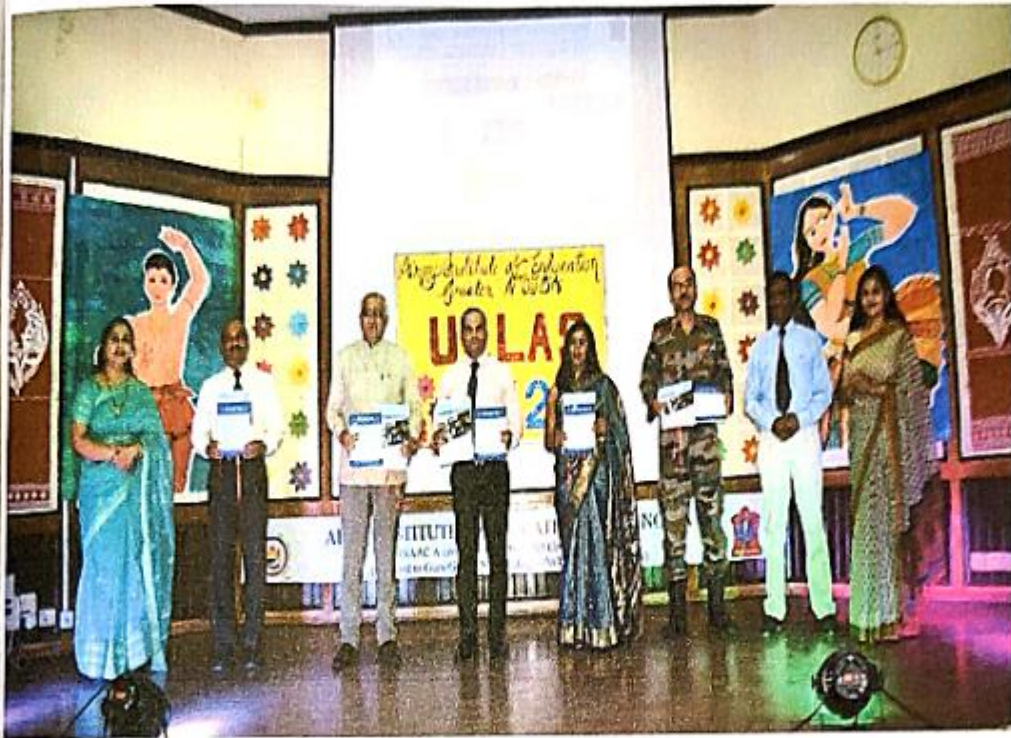
