1st session

Mr. Ajay Sharma of B.Ed. Batch 2019-2021 currently the Vice Principal of Aryabhatta Educational Academy, Agra led the first talk series on virtual platform on the topic "Beyond the school teaching" on 01 Feb 2022. Mr. Ajay Sharma started with the presentation and intrigued the viewers by asking the questions regarding the other activities other than the academics and provided us with the information, where we can teach other than school or institute. The platforms that sir mentioned was Bju's, Vedantu, Unacademy, Textbook, Teachmint, doubtnut. He then specifically told us about the BYJU's Academy that hires good teacher and told us that it is a good platform to enhance your teaching skills and to be financially independent. 2nd Session

The 2nd day of Alumni Talk Series was organized on 26th February 2022 on the topic "HYBRID TEACHING" by our esteem guest Miss Sadhana (Batch 2019-2021). She is working as Middle School Teacher at Baldwin boys high school in Bangalore. The session was started with a brief introduction of Miss Sadhana and ma'am was welcomed by our Principal Dr Abhilasha Gautam, Army Institute of Education, Greater Noida. She started the session with the term hybrid teaching and explained what this term means (Hybrid teaching does not assume either a fundamentally on-campus or fundamentally online model but is designed for easy student transition between the two. Hybrid teaching will consist of a mixture of digital and on-campus activities, where students may be able to attend on-campus sessions, digital sessions in the same time zone, or digital sessions in a different time zone.) At the end doubt clearing session was there in which student teachers asked their question to Miss Sadhana ma'am followed by vote of thanks by Dr Jyoti Tiwari, Assistant Professor, AIE. Overall, the session was very informative, interesting and joyful.

3rd Session

On Third day of Alumni Talk Session organized on 03th March 2022 on the Topic "Being Fresher, is it a challenge?" by Ms. Pratiksha. The session was started with the brief introduction of Ms. Pratiksha.


