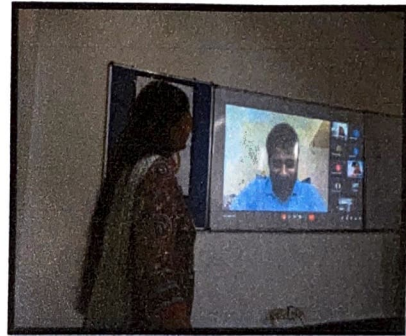


A slogan writing event was also organized house wise with students participating with full enthusiasm & each house contributing 5 slogans on the theme of Earth Day



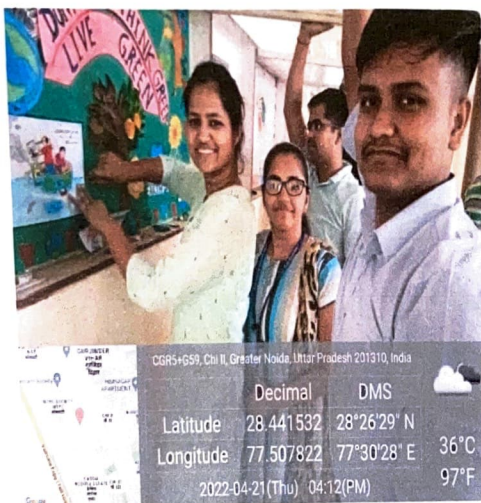
Day 3 (20th April 2022)

Day 4 (21st April 2022)

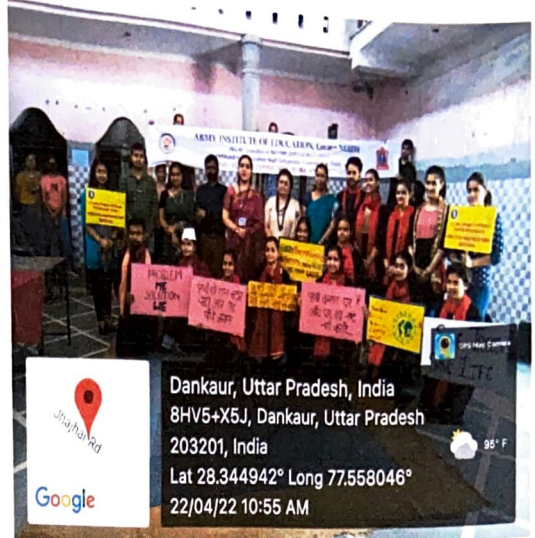

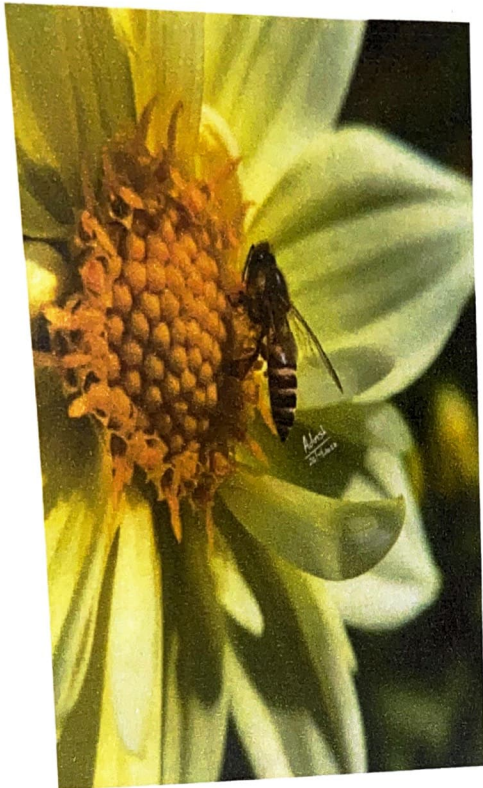

Day 6 (23rd April 2022)


On the final day of the "Earth Week" an intra college 'Photography Competition' organized on the theme of nature. The competition saw many entries from the students, which were submitted online to
