Report on - 'Desh Ke Mentor'

Army Institute of Education organised an Orientation Programme for **Desh Ke Mentor** for NSS volunteers, student teachers of B.Ed. and B.Ed. Spl. Ed. of Batch 2021-23 and 2022-24 on 27 Sep 2022. The objective of the programme was to orient NSS volunteers regarding the program/flagship of Delhi Government in relation to Mentoring Delhi Government School children. Ms Komal Choudhary, Asst Prof, AIE and NSS Incharge, coordinated the programme. Ms Shikha Mishra and Ms Neha student teachers of B.Ed. and B.Ed. Sp Ed. respectively were the Master of Ceremony to conduct the event. The event commenced with felicitation of the resource persons Mr. Abhinay Pratap Singh, Project Head, Desh Ke Mentor Ms Ekta Gupta, Project Manager, Desh Ke Mentor and Mr. Ankit, Desh Ke Mentor by Dr Abhilasha Gautam, Principal, AIE followed by her welcome address.

Mr. Abhinay Pratap Singh in his deliberation apprised the audience about Delhi Government's Desh Ke Mentor' programme. He explained the process of becoming the part of the programme after downloading the app and registering themselves in the programme. The he along with Ms Ekta Gupta, Project Manager conducted an Ice Breaking Round for the students. After the activity, Mr Ankit, Desh Ke Mentor took over the session and briefed the students about the Desh Ke Mentor app in more detail. He discussed the salient features of the app and about the requirement of mentoring the children of Delhi Government schools.

He also emphasised that the children cannot share everything with their family members and teachers, so they need mentors from outside. Mentors are expected to be their safe space for sharing personal and academic issues. He highlighted that the Mentors can act as cheerleaders and motivators to the students. Students can also get guidance from Mentors when they feel depressed and anxious.

At the end pf the session, Mr. Abhinay Pratap Singh addressed the queries raised by the teachers and students. Dr Abhilasha Gautam, Principal, AIE expressed her gratitude to the Management of the Institute for providing the platform for organising such event and to the resource persons for conducting an enlightening session.

Outcome of the Event- The orientation programme helped in instilling the idea of social welfare in students, and to provide service to society without bias.
