EXHIBITION OF LOW COST TLMS

As we are heading towards a sustainable future and targeting SDGs for 2030, considering this theme AIE organized an exhibition on 6th June 2023 recommended by National Council for Teacher Education (NCTE), showcasing different Teaching Learning Materials (TLMs) made of low-cost material that can be recycled, reused and this can reduce wastage of resources. It helps us in contributing to one of the 17 SDGs (Responsible consumption and Production).

The faculty and student-teachers of AIE visited the exhibition and volunteer students of BED Batch 2021-23 have briefed them about the making of the low-cost TLMs. The TLMs were made of cardboard, used chart papers, discarded materials etc. This helped the student-teachers in getting ideas to make future sustainable TLMs at low-cost. Using such TLMs at school also helps the students in understanding usage of resources wisely.

With this attempt, Army Institute of Education, Greater NOIDA made an effort in spreading awareness about sustainable use of resources and motivated the future teachers to make use of low-cost yet sustainable resources. Such efforts remind us that we are a responsible for the consumption of resources on Earth and it is our prime duty to use them judiciously.

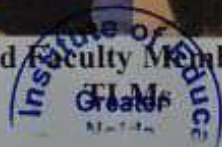

Participation of Student Teachers and Faculty Members during the Exhibition on Low Cost

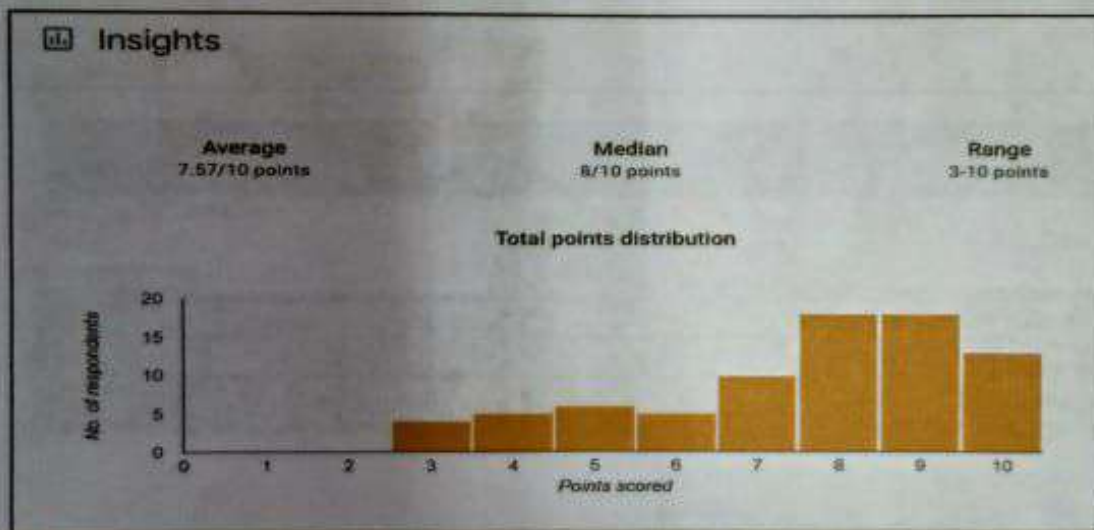


DAY 2 - 09.06.23

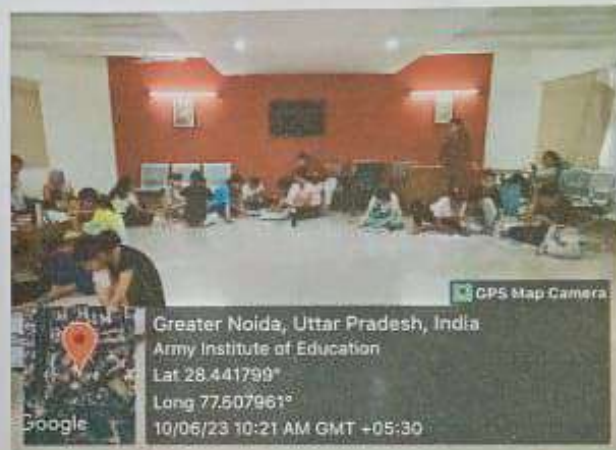

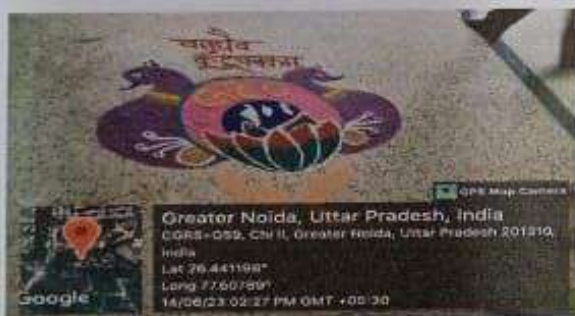

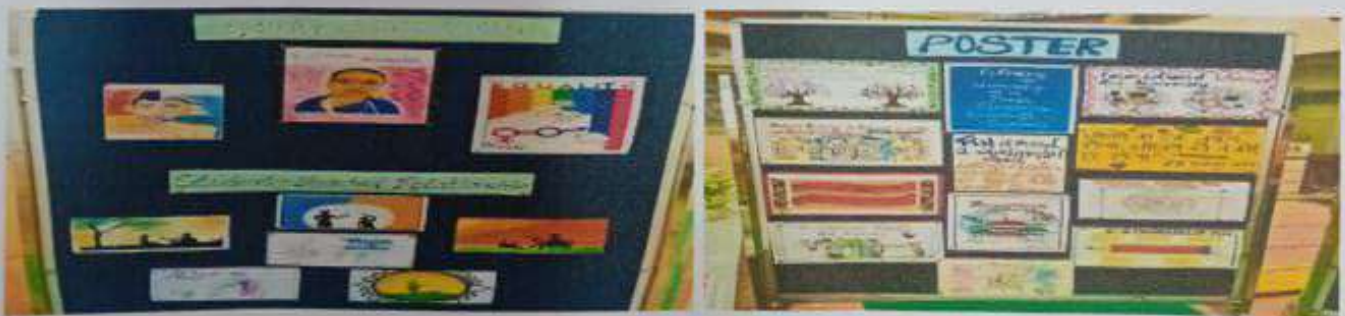
Painting Exhibition

Inauguration by Dr. Abhilasha Gautam Welcome & Feedback Board of Painting Exhibition(Principal AIE)

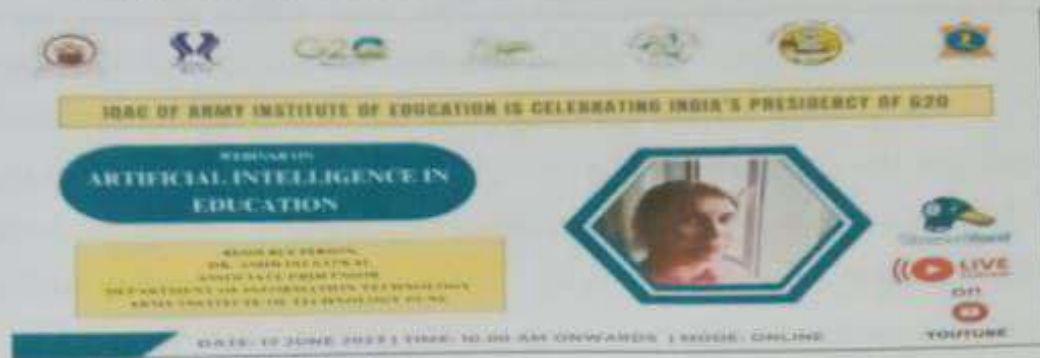

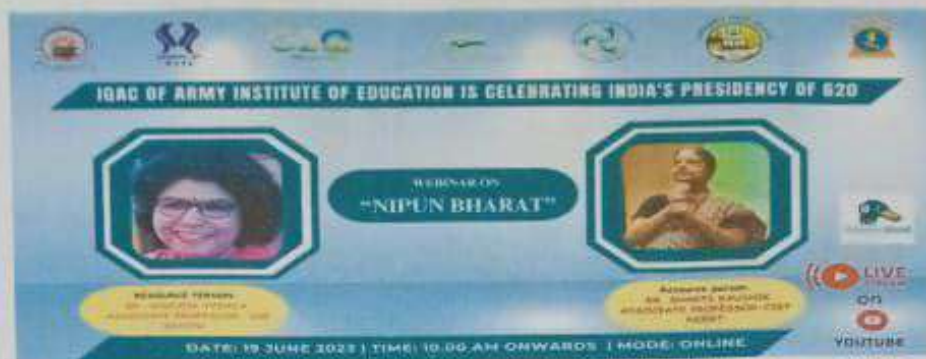

WEBINAR ON "NIPUN BHARAT"



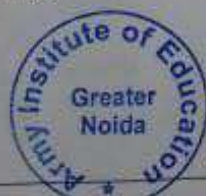

The vision for foundational literacy and numeracy is to enable children to become independent and engaged readers and writers who are able to transition from „learning to read,, to „reading to learn” and from „learning to write ,, to „writing for academic success and pleasure”. Children demonstrate an understanding of numbers and knowledge of mathematical concepts, make connections between related ideas and progressively apply their understanding in new and unfamiliar contexts. To achieve the vision



it is important that we understand the present status of reading and writing among children in the country. Various researches conducted in the country point out that the children are facing a learning crisis.

The Ministry of Education, Government of India has launched the National Initiative for Proficiency in Reading with Understanding and Numeracy (NIPUN Bharat) mission along with a detailed implementation guideline for the states to ensure that every child in the country necessarily attains foundational literacy and numeracy (FLN) by the end of Grade 3, by 2026-27. The convenor of this conference was **Ms. Kriti Guleria**, Assistant Professor at AIE.
