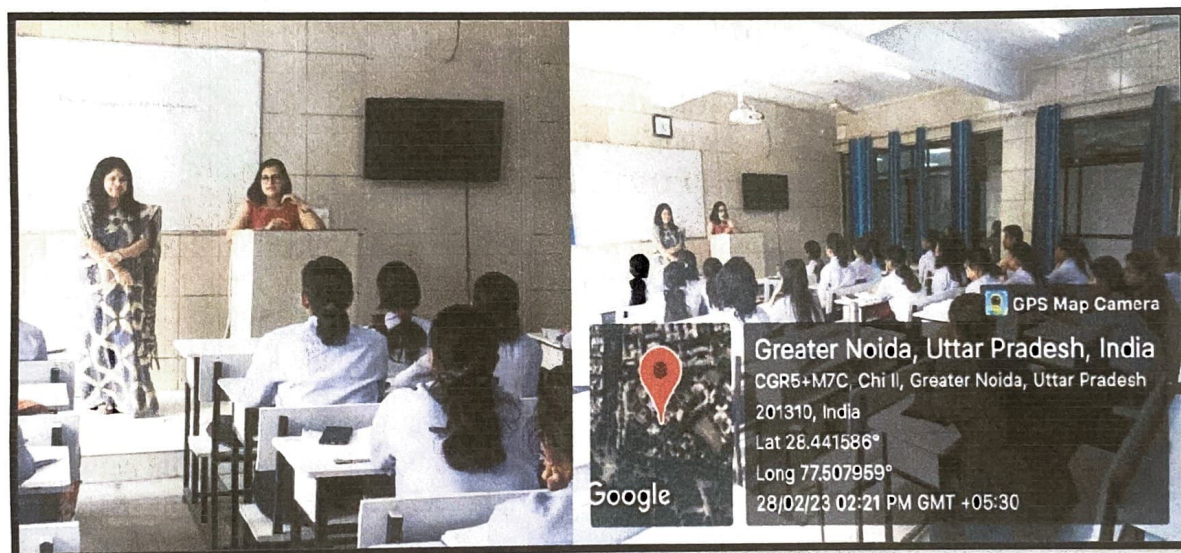

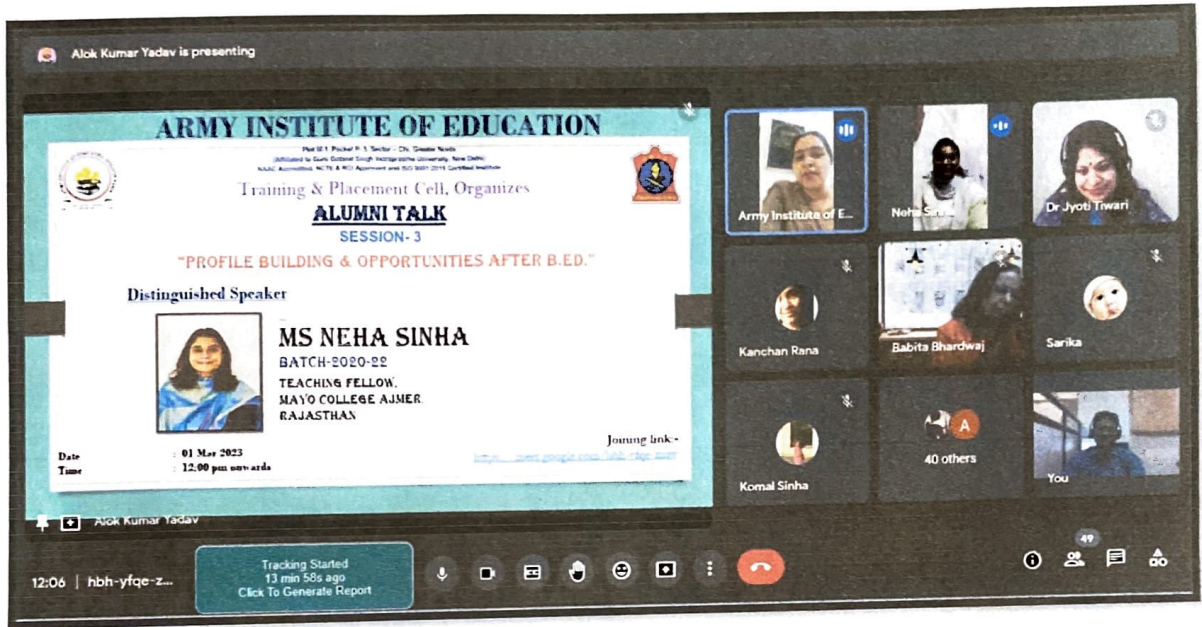

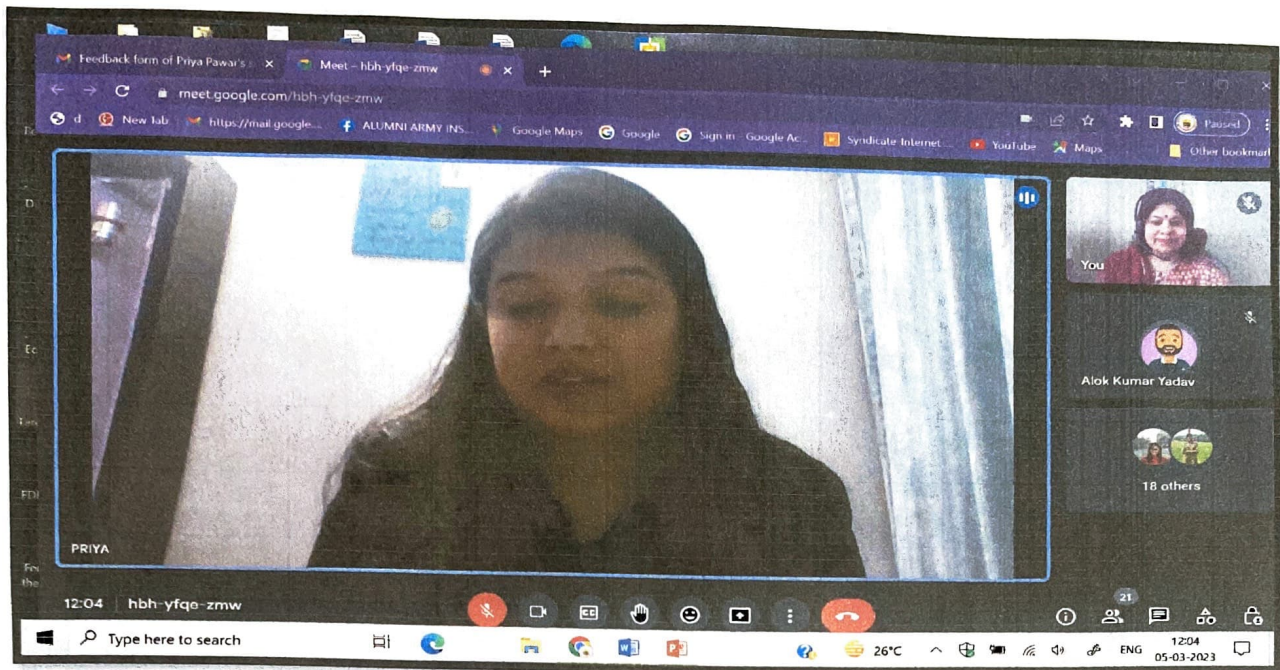
ALUMNI TALK-4
