National Seminar Report

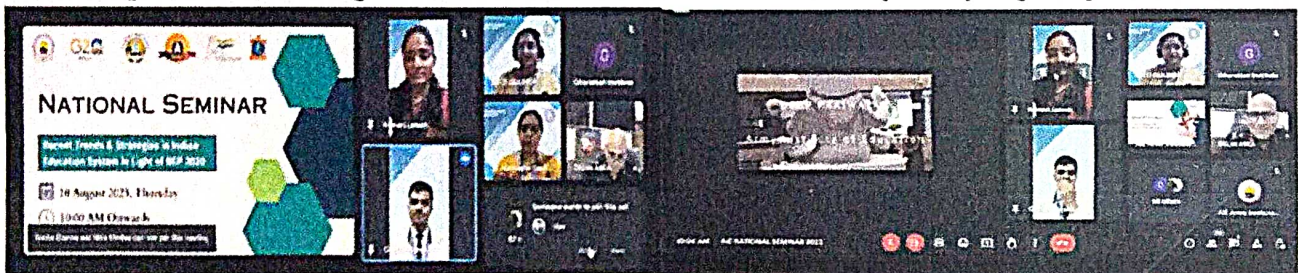

The Inaugural Session began with Saraswati Vandana followed by Lamp Lighting.

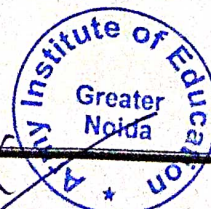

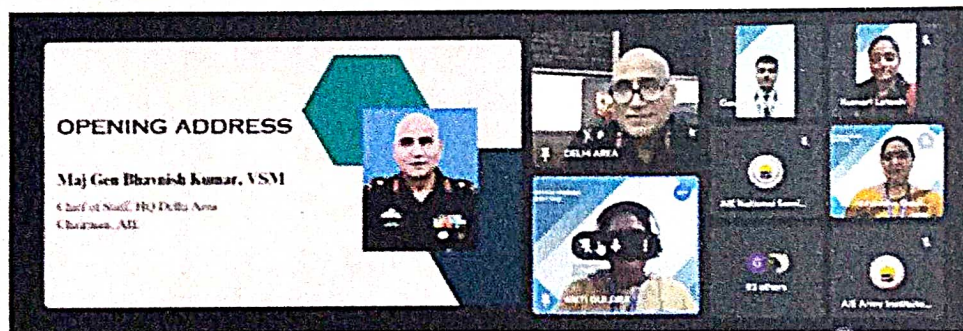

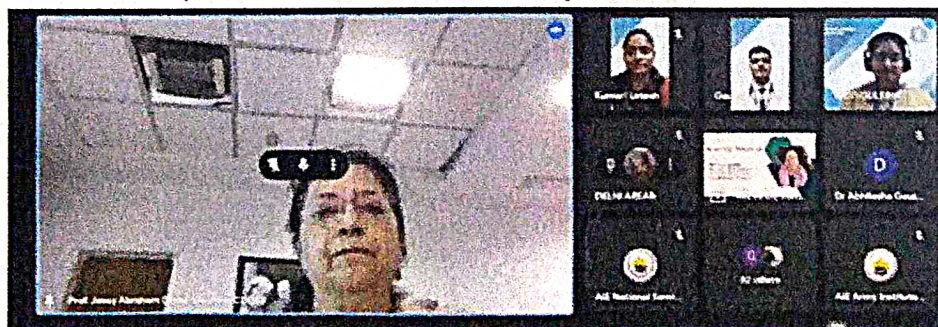

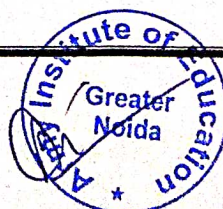

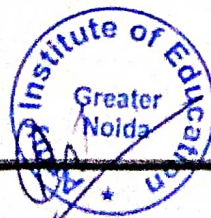
Technical Sessions

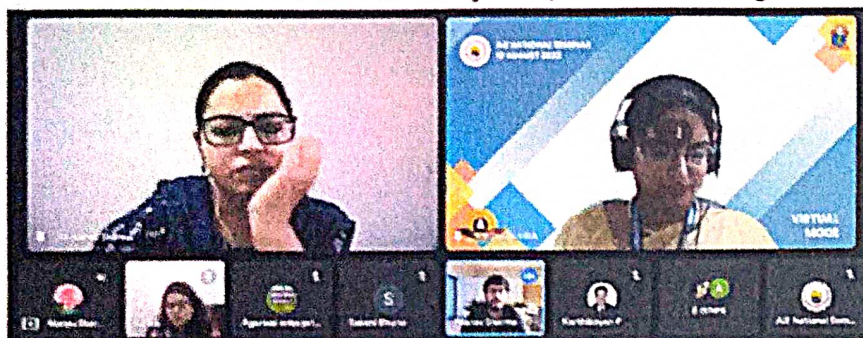

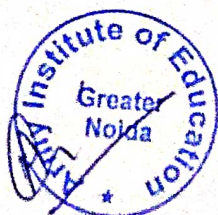

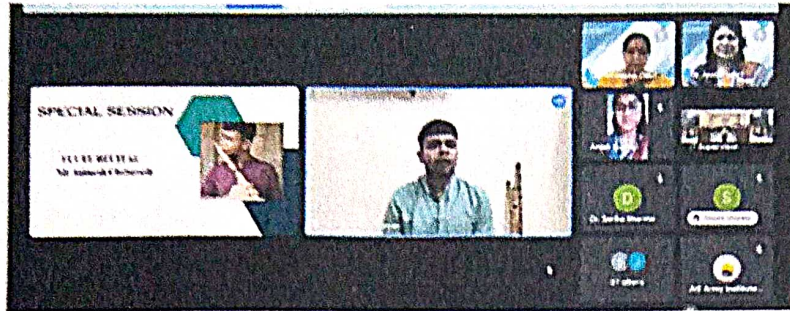

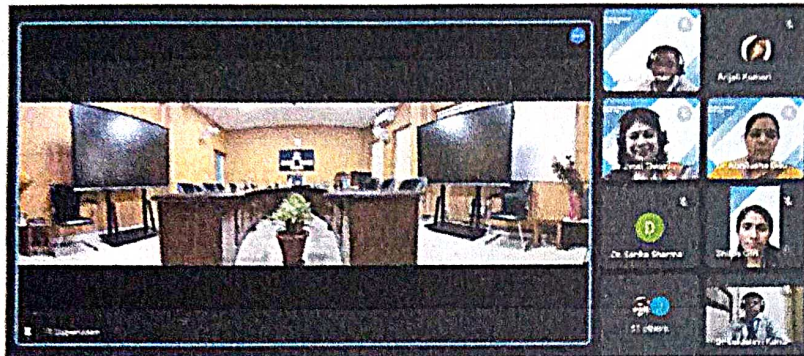
Valedictory session

Valedictory session started by flute performance by Mr. Animesh Chaturvedi Flute Plyaer



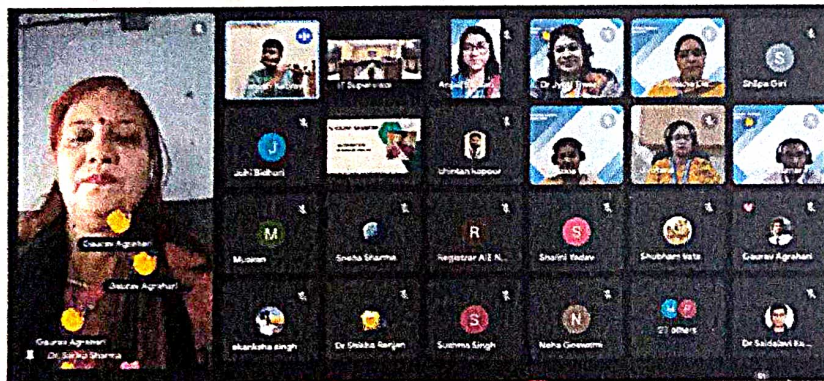

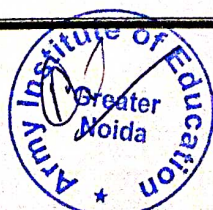

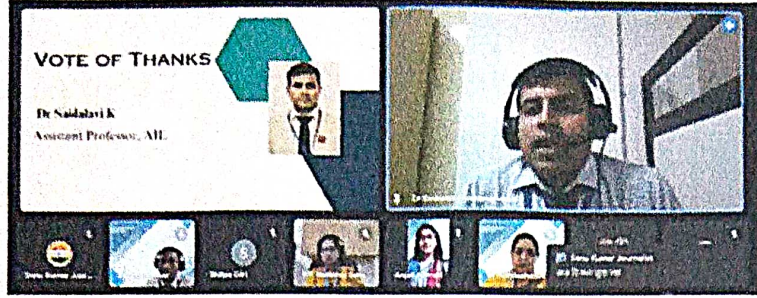
