Report on "Earthquake Alert Meeting" Batch 2023-25

3 October 2023

Army Institute of Education had organised an "Earthquake Alert Meeting" for B.Ed and B.Ed Spl (LD) students of Batch 2023-25 on 3 October 2023. The primary aim of this meeting was to create awareness among the faculty members and students with the necessary knowledge of how to react immediately and appropriately when an earthquake strikes. This meeting was held immediately after strong tremors were felt in Delhi on 3 October 2023 after multiple earthquakes hit Nepal - of 4.6 at 2.25 PM and 6.2 magnitude at 2.50 PM, a third of 3.8 magnitude 15 minutes after, and a fourth of 3.1 magnitude 13 minutes later, at 3.19 PM IST. The earthquake tremors were felt in Delhi and other parts of the national capital region. Faculty and students reported strong tremors after the second earthquake and evacuated college building. Col Abhay Rajwanshi (Registrar, AIE) and Dr. Abhilasha Gautam (Principal, AIE) asked the students, faculty members and non-teaching staff to gather in herbal garden.

The following precautionary measures were advised to the students -

1. If You Are Inside

- Stay inside. Do not get in a doorway — this does not provide protection from falling or flying objects, and you might not be able to remain standing.
- **Drop, Cover, and Hold On**
 - **Drop** down to the ground so the earthquake doesn't knock you down.
 - **Cover** your head and neck with your arms to protect you from falling debris. If possible, crawl under a sturdy desk, table or other piece of furniture for additional protection. Stay away from glass, windows, outside doors and walls, and other items that could fall.
 - **Hold** on to any sturdy item you can until the shaking stops.

2. If You Are Outside

- Move away from buildings, streetlights, and utility wires.

3. If You Are in a Vehicle

- Pull to the side of the road and stay inside until the earthquake is over. Do not stop under overpasses or power lines.
