VISIT TO

MATA BHAGWANTI CHADHA NIKETAN

SPECIAL SCHOOL, NOIDA

The visit to Mata Bhagwanti Chadha Niketan, a charitable special school for mentally and physically challenged children, was organized on October 25, 2023. The purpose of this visit was to provide an opportunity for the B.Ed. and B.Ed. Special Education students from the Army Institute of Education to gain practical insights into the education and care of children with special needs. The school is known for its exemplary services and support for differently-abled children. The Date scheduled for the visit was on October 25, 2023 from 10:00 AM - 1:00 PM. The faculty in charge for the visit was Miss. Komal Chaudhary (Assistant Professor, AIE), Dr. Jyoti Tiwari (Assistant Professor, AIE), and Dr. Azkia Khan (Assistant Professor, AIE). The numbers of participants in this school visit were seventy-nine.

The visit to Mata Bhagwanti Chadha Niketan School was an eye-opening experience for our students. They gained a deeper understanding of the challenges faced by children with special needs and the comprehensive approach required to support them. The dedication of the staff and the progress made by the students left a lasting impression.

Visiting School's Facilities:

- Special Educators: The students observed highly trained special educators who
 catered to the diverse needs of the students. The educators employed a variety of
 techniques to engage and educate the children effectively.
- Speech Therapists: Speech therapists at the school worked diligently with children
 who had communication difficulties. The students observed how speech therapy
 sessions were adapted to suit the individual needs of each child.

- <u>Physiotherapists</u>: The school employed physiotherapists who worked on improving the physical abilities of the students. This was a crucial aspect of the visit, as it highlighted the importance of physical therapy in the development of children with physical disabilities.
- Occupational Therapists: Occupational therapists were observed assisting students in developing essential life skills. They worked on activities to improve fine motor skills and enhance daily living capabilities.
- <u>Psychologists:</u> The students had the opportunity to interact with psychologists who
 provided counselling and emotional support to children and their families. They
 emphasized the importance of addressing the emotional well-being of special needs
 children.
- Vocational Counsellors: The vocational counsellors played a crucial role in preparing students for future employment and independent living. The students witnessed vocational training sessions that helped children acquire valuable skills.
- Visiting Child Specialist: The presence of a visiting child specialist was noted. This
 specialist offered comprehensive medical support and guidance to children with
 complex medical needs.
- The outcomes from a school visit to Mata Bhagwanti Chadha Niketan Special School were that it created greater awareness and understanding of the challenges and unique needs of students with special needs. It gave participants an insight into the school's inclusive education practices and strategies for integrating students with disabilities into regular classrooms and learned about the importance of individualized education plans (IEPs) and how they are tailored to meet the specific needs of each student. Opportunity to observe and learn about adaptive teaching methods and tools used to support students with disabilities, such as assistive technology, specialized curriculum, and teaching techniques and along with that Understand how the school supports the emotional and social development of students with special needs. The visit emphasized the importance of practical exposure for students pursuing B.Ed. and B.Ed. Special Education. It is recommended that such visits become a regular part of the curriculum to enhance the students' understanding of special education and the techniques employed to address the needs of differently-abled children.

To conclude, it can said so, that the visit to Mata Bhagwanti Chadha Niketan was a valuable learning experience for the students. It underscored the significance of inclusive education
