Vision of the TPC: Preparing student-teachers with professional skills and crafting new directions for enhancing their employability in various fields of education.

Objectives of the TPC:

- to guide student-teachers to choose right career and to give knowledge, skill, and aptitude and meet the manpower requirements of the educational institutions.
- to assist student-teachers to develop/clarify their academic and career interests, and their short and long-term goals through individual counselling and group sessions.
- to maintain and regularly update the database of student-teachers and alumni.

- to provide information to student-teachers and alumni on upcoming job vacancies in the field of education.
- to coordinate with schools and remain well informed on the requirements and recruitment procedures.
- to identify the needs and expectations of the schools to assist them in recruiting most suitable candidates.
- to organize pre-placement training/workshops/seminars for student-teachers.
- to act as a link between students, alumni, and the employment community.
- to provide career guidance through regularly updating departmental notice boards regarding competitive examinations, job opportunities in government sector, off campus drives etc.

The schools are always on the outlook for the teachers who are vibrant, energetic individuals and ready to accept challenges, attentive, having good academic background, easily adaptable to the working atmosphere, open to learning even at work and more importantly having good communication skills.

Keeping in view the schools' requirements the Training & Placement Cell AIE focusses on the following aspects:

- Communicating with schools for campus interviews

The Training & Placement cell helps the students to enhance their soft-skills, to prepare the students for interviews and demo lessons and to groom their overall personality. Along with this, the cell also identifies suitable and reputed institutes and helps them achieve their hiring goals. The well functioned Training & Placement Cell of AIE acts as a bridge between students, alumni and recruiters.

Army Institute of Education, Greater NOIDA being a fully residential institute get highly talented student teachers from diverse backgrounds from all over the country.

To provide the student- teachers the opportunity to work at their preferred location, a job location preference list is prepared at the initial stage of the placement process, so that the TPC is able to liaison with the schools accordingly.

To enhance the visibility of the most suitable candidates to the recruiters, TPC prepared the first placement brochure for the batch 2017-19 which was uploaded on the website and also circulated through mails to the reputed schools of Delhi NCR and to all the Army Public Schools, pan India.

A Placement Policy was instituted with the approval of the Chairman of the Institute and filled by all the student- teachers before commencing the campus placement drive.




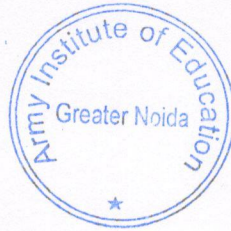
