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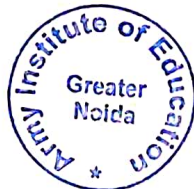

#### **1. Personality Development Programme-**

The personality Development Program covered various aspects, including portfolio website development, resume writing, communication skills, emotional intelligence, email etiquette for job applicants, and the use of rubrics for assessment and evaluation.

- ❖ Participants learned to build a professional portfolio website, showcasing their skills and work samples to potential employers.
- ❖ The workshop on resume writing provided insights into crafting effective resumes tailored to stand out to employers.
- ❖ Participants enhanced their communication skills, including verbal and non-verbal aspects, active listening, and effective speaking techniques.
- ❖ The program emphasized emotional intelligence, enabling participants to comprehend and manage emotions for personal and professional success.

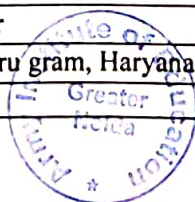




