 - Facilitates should be developed for differently abled faculty and students.
 - d) The focus on minor and major research projects.
 - e) Formal IQAC, Alumni and consultancy services should be augmented.
 - f) Long term faculty development programmes should be planned and executed.
 - g) Research culture be promoted by providing financial assistance, extra ordinary leave and up gradations under career advancement scheme.
 - h) Teaching and non-teaching staff ratio be logically and rationally streamlined.
 - j) Extension services should be strengthened.
 - k) Faculty exchange programme be intimated through collaborations/MOUs.
