- 2. <u>Discn on Completion of the Course</u>- Coordinators informed all the members that syllabus of theory as well as practical will be completed on time for both the batches and internal exams have also been conducted from 16 Mar 2017 to 21 Mar 2017.
- 3. <u>Seminars / Workshops/ Panel Discussion etc attended by faculty</u>: Principal and two faculty members attended orientation programme, seminar and Conclave.
- 4. <u>Seminar funded by UGC, NCERT or NAAC</u>. Principal recommended to organise UGC, NCERT or NAAC funded seminar in 2018.
- 5. International Conference- During 29 IMC Meeting, Chairman AIE directed Ms Pratibha Garg to organise International Conference at AIE.
