**4. Campus Placement Drive-** Placement drive for the Batch 2022-24 commenced on 03 Feb, 2024, employing both online and offline modes. Given the distance situation, certain schools opted for online procedures. We forwarded the resumes of interested students to schools in response to specific job postings. Following a thorough review of these resumes, schools provided us with a selection of students they wished to invite for online interviews and demo of teaching skills. We subsequently requested them to share the appointment letters with us for record purposes.


**Leadership Development:** Sessions on leadership aimed to cultivate leadership qualities and empower participants to take on leadership roles with confidence and competence.


