- Promoting Ethical Practices: Emphasizing the importance of ethical conduct in research and publication.

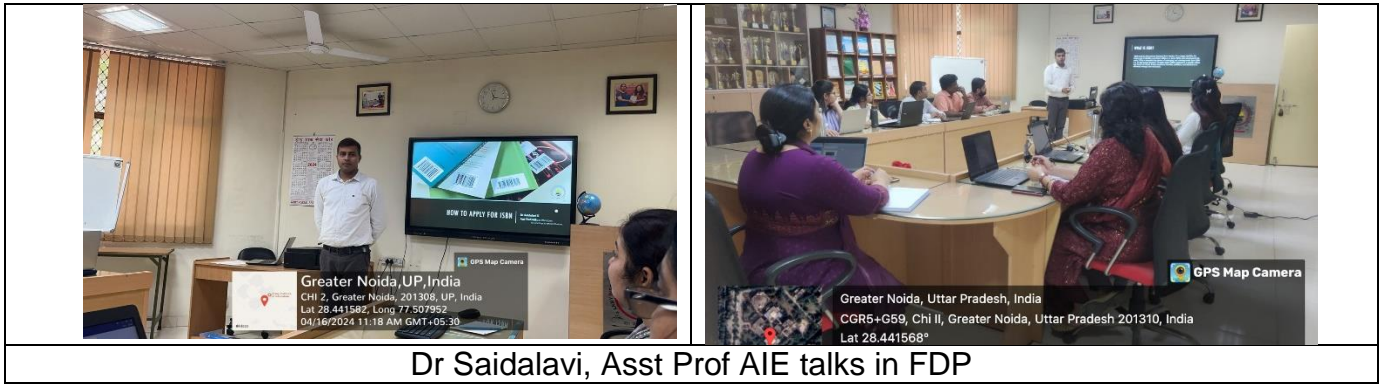

#### **Day 1:**

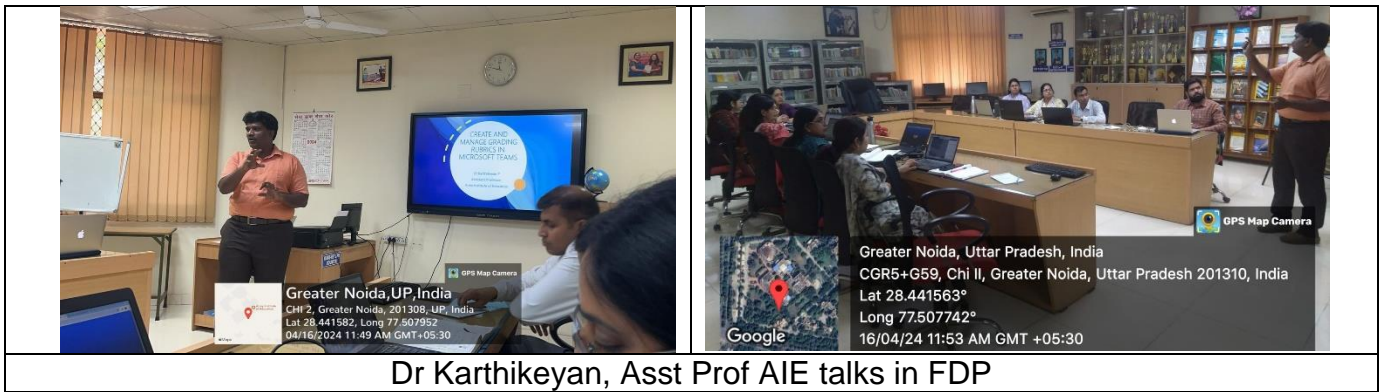
(Tuesday, 16 April 2024)

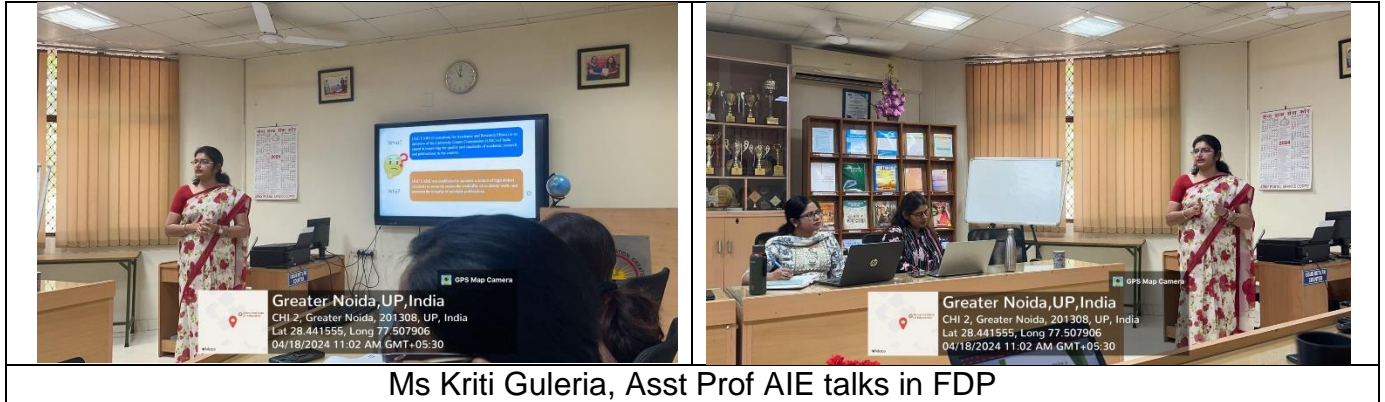

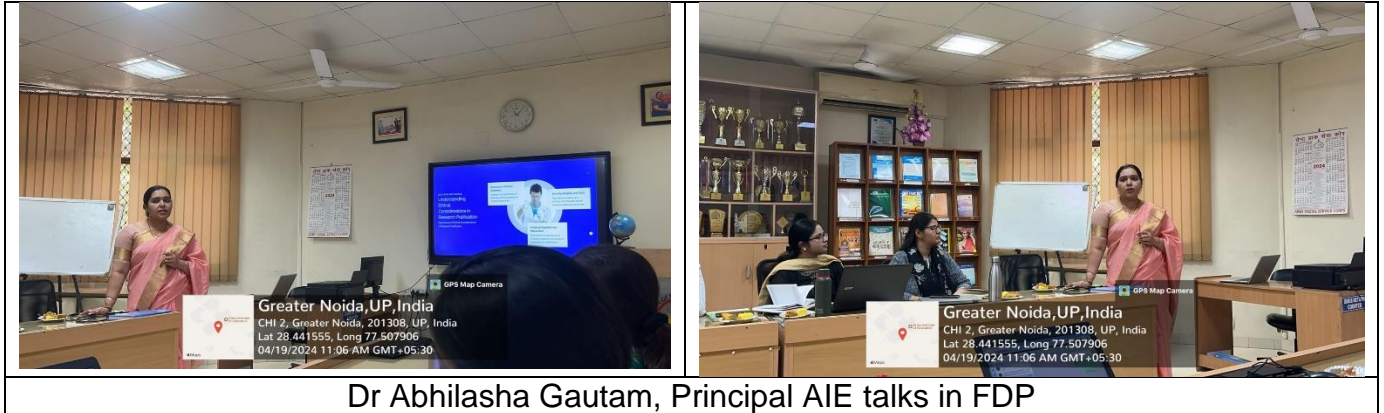

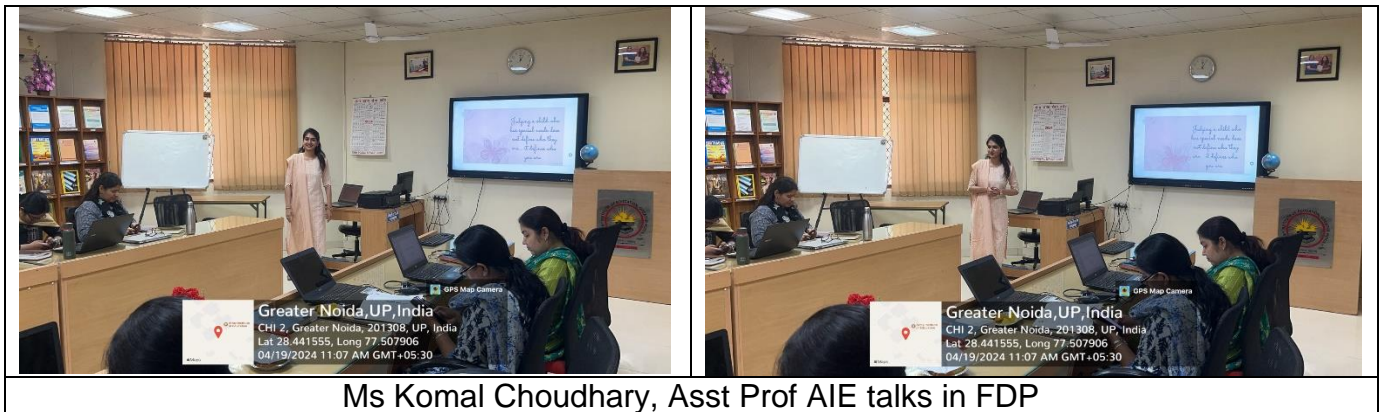
(Friday, 19 April 2024)

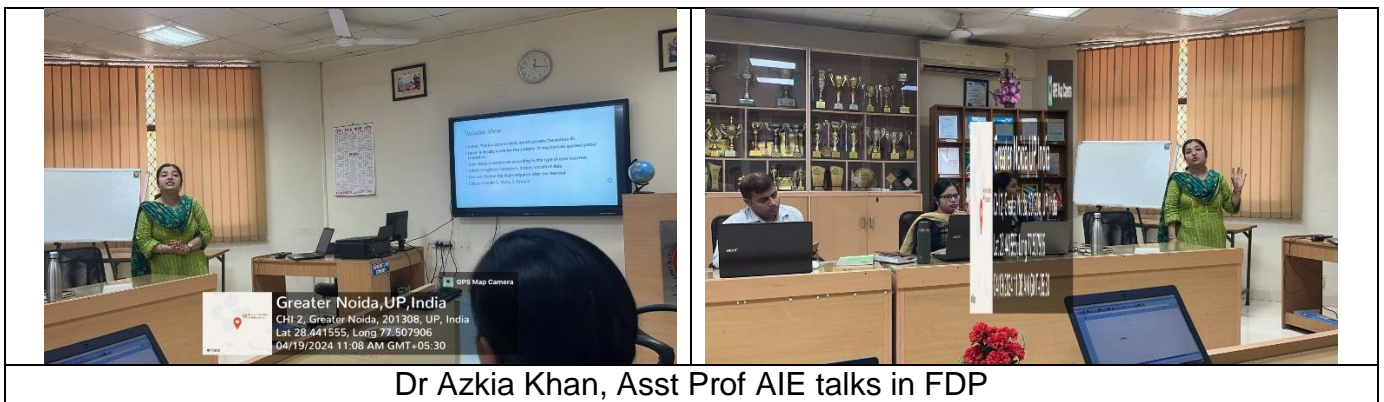

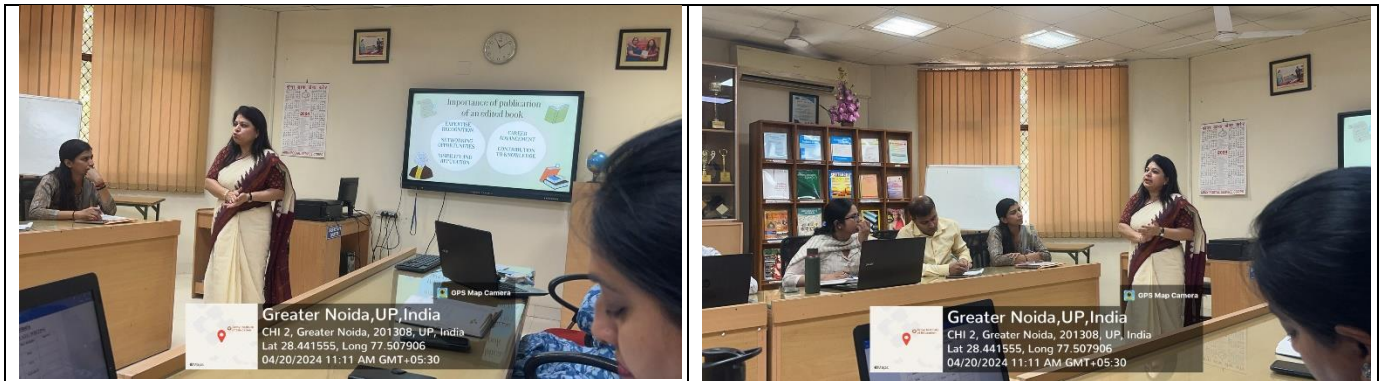

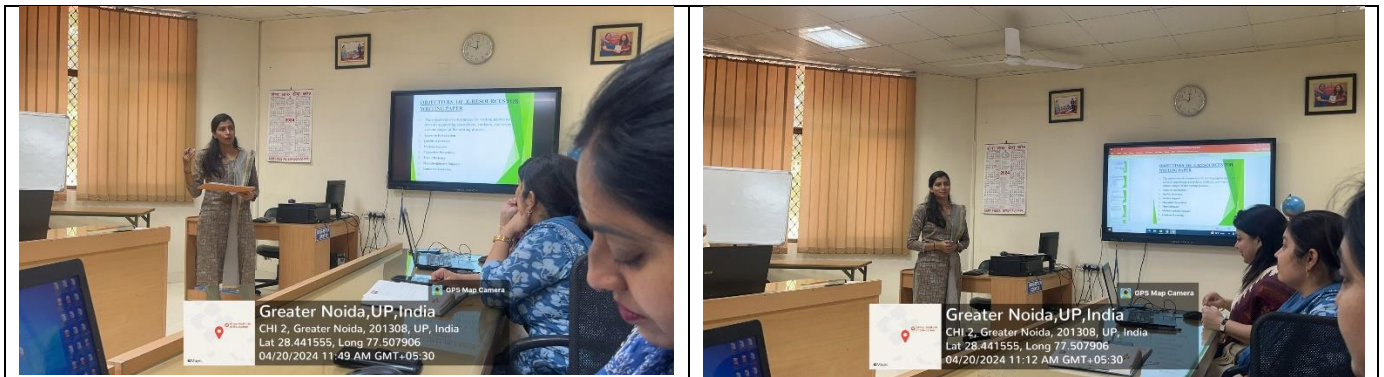
(Saturday, 20 April 2024)

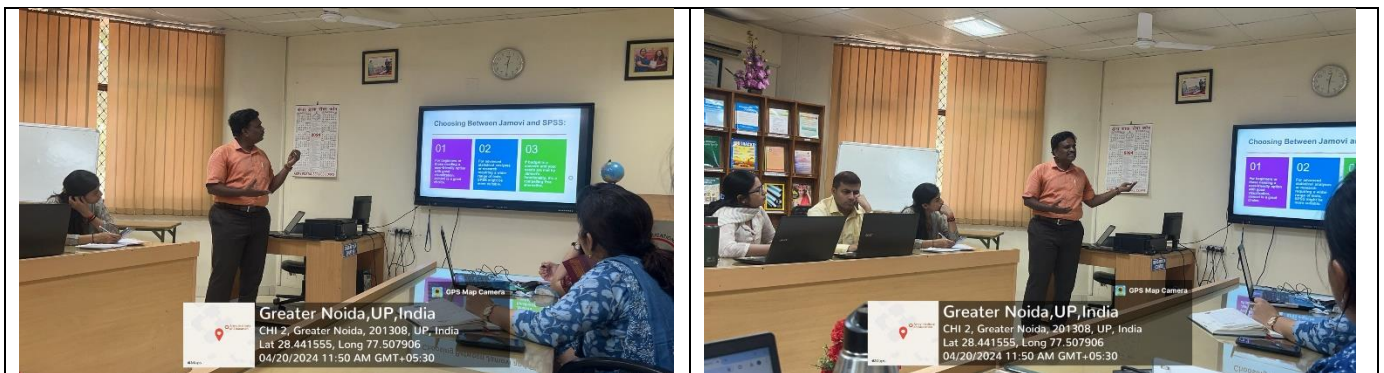

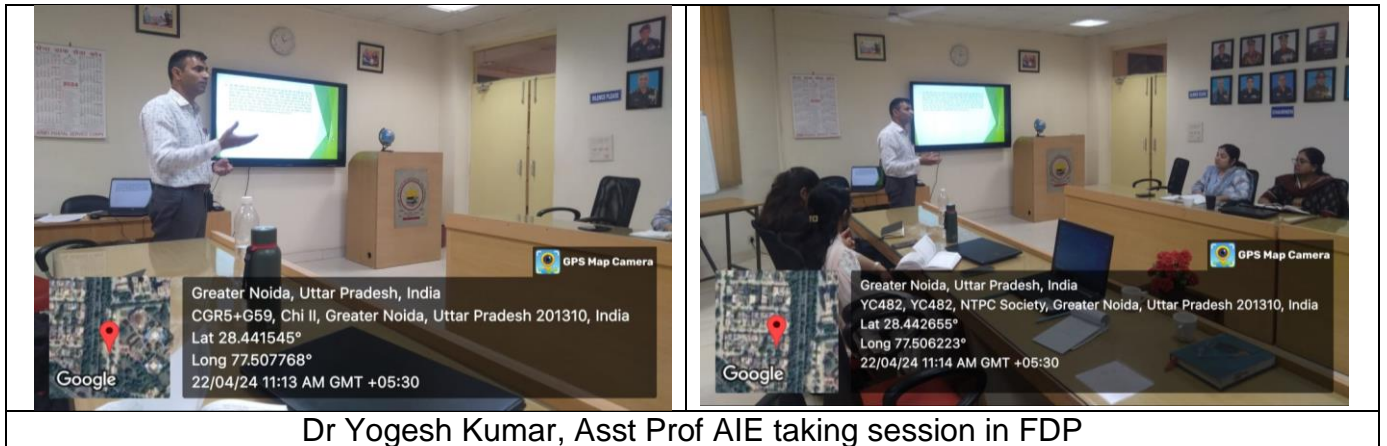

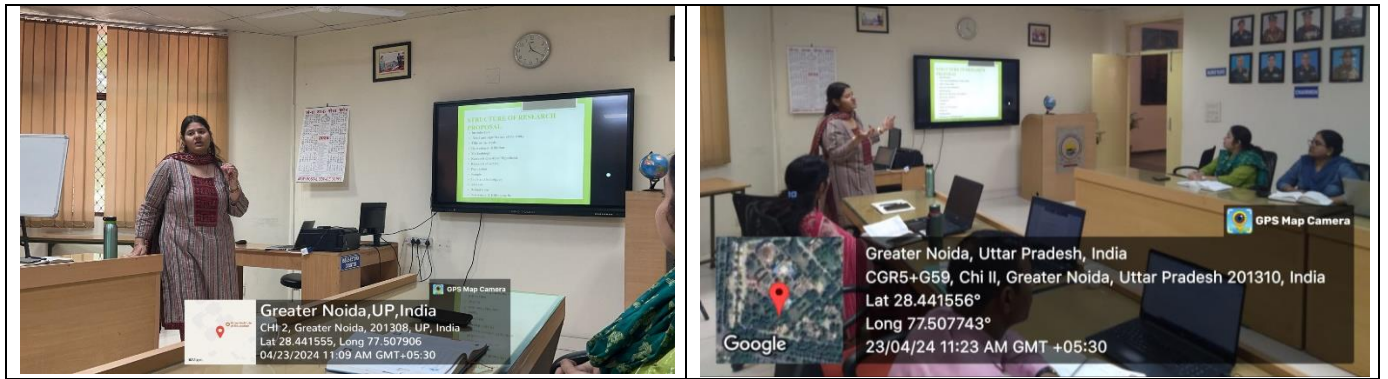

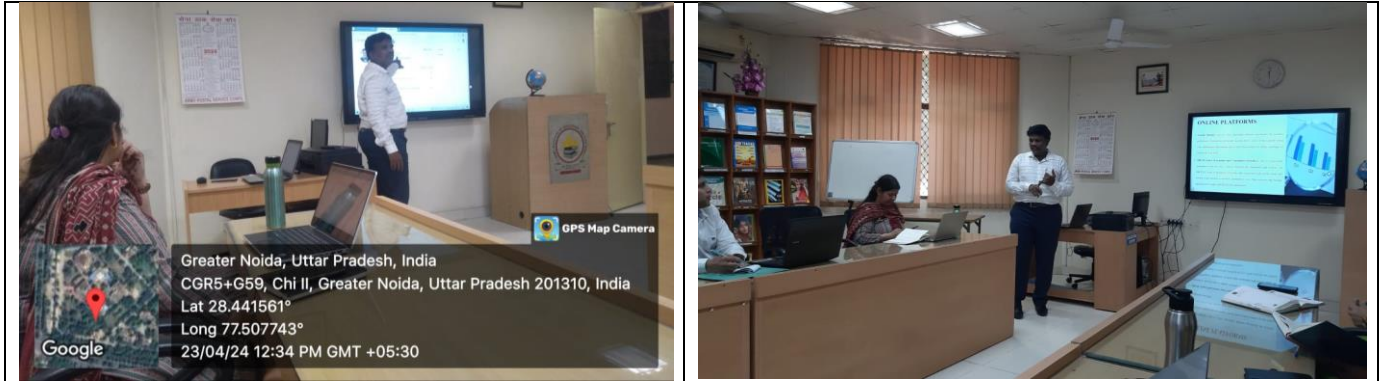
