#### Report on 'Orientation Session on Educational Loan Facilities'


Date: 09 Aug 2023

The webinar concluded with the singing of the national anthem, symbolizing unity and patriotism among the participants.






It also aimed to empower attendees with knowledge, resources, and a commitment to making a positive difference in the lives of those with dyslexia.







