
WORKSHOP 2




what is the format of the formal covering letter and what qualifications and skills should be provided on a job application.


With proper team effort and cooperation, we were able to complete the given task on time and enjoyed the activity.

DAY 4 (22.09.2022) HOW TO MAKE RESUME?


On Day 4 Mr. Preetam Nayak explained us How to make a attractive resume so these are the steps shown by him and he told each individual to make a resume.
