1	Admissions 2024	Dr Abhilasha Gautam apprised the house about the low positive response from the admission aspirants for the admission in the session 2024-25. Suggestions were taken from the faculty and discussions held to increase the strength of the Institution. Faculty gave consent after detailed discussion on the following points: a. Conduction of classes in FDRC, Shankar Vihar for aspirants who are unable to attend physical classes at the Institute. b. Live classes to be undertaken for distantly placed students. c. Core Team will be prepared to undertake the classes at FDRC. d. Orientation ad sensitization for ITEP will be undertaken for class XI & XII from in APSs all over the country. e. Routine & regular publicity through social media. Small videos, reels, pictures from various activities undertaken at the Institute to be posted regularly.
