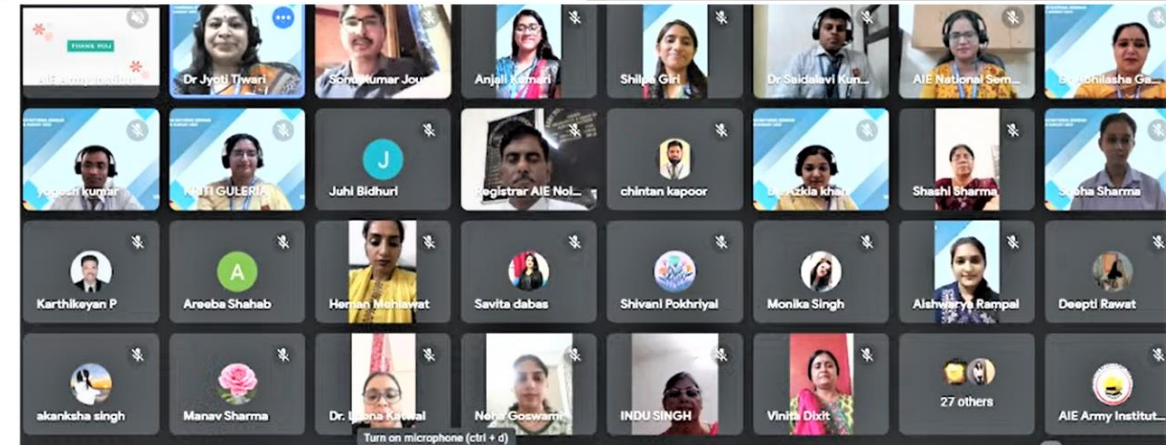
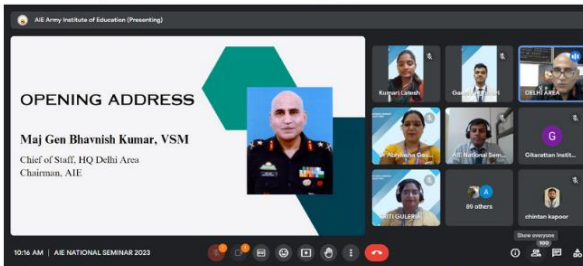
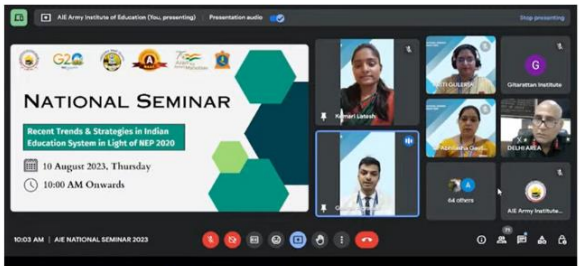
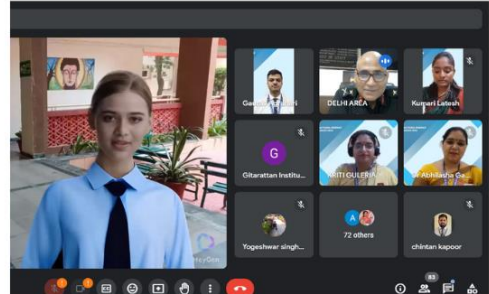
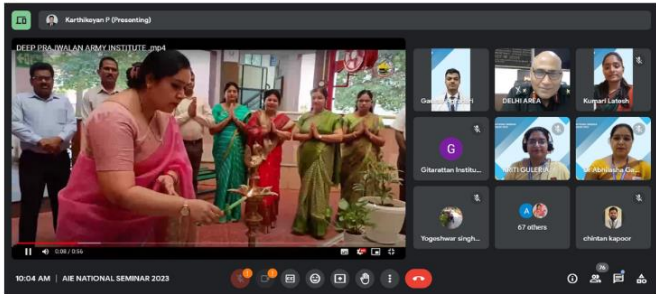


**NATIONAL SEMINAR on RECENT TRENDS & STRATEGIES IN INDIAN

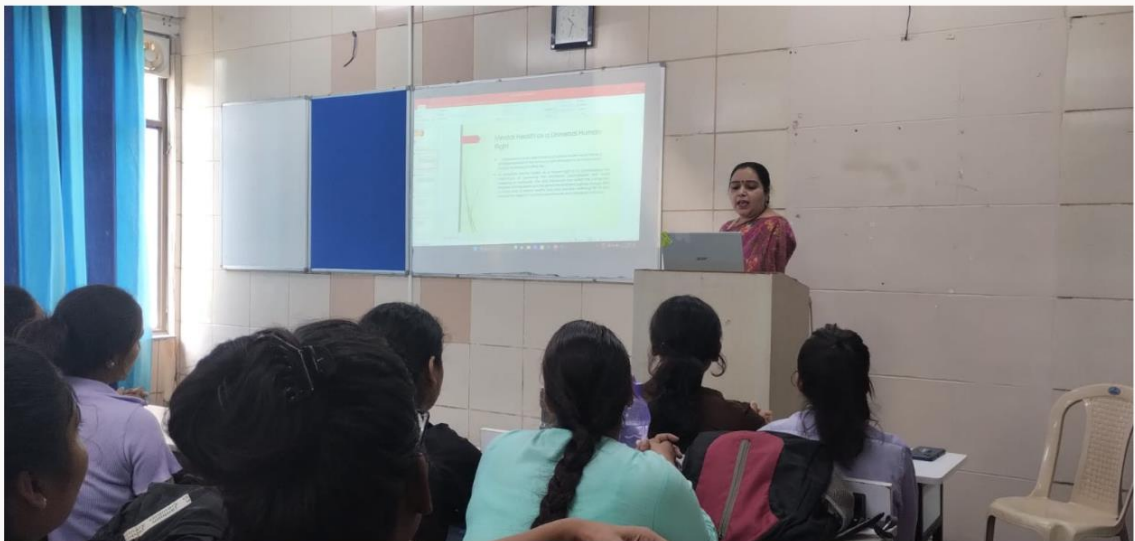


MENTAL HEALTH AWARENESS WEEK

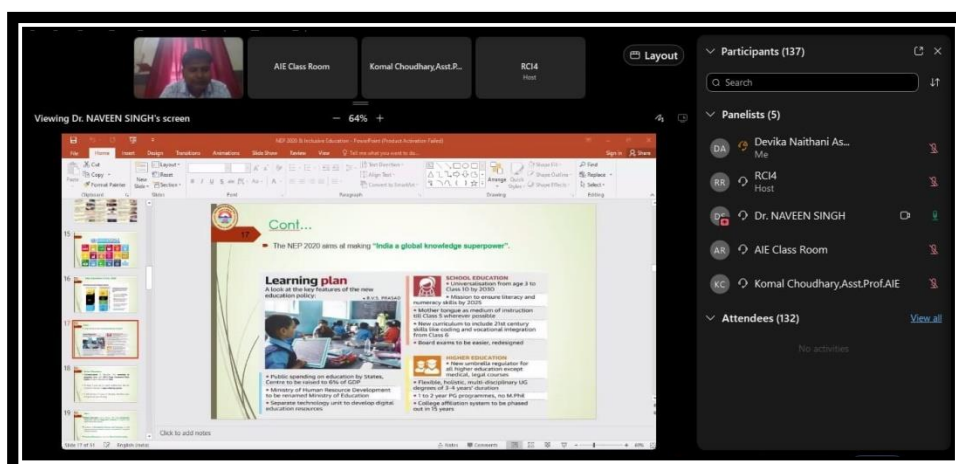
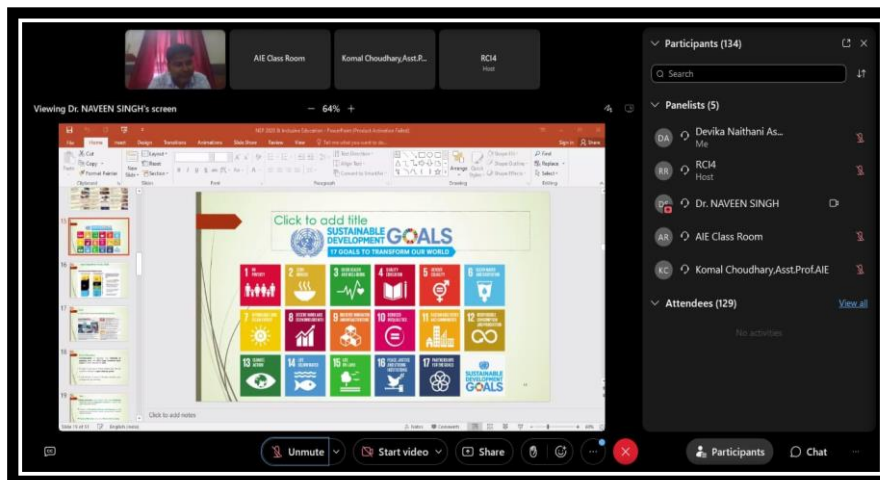
NATIONAL WEBINAR

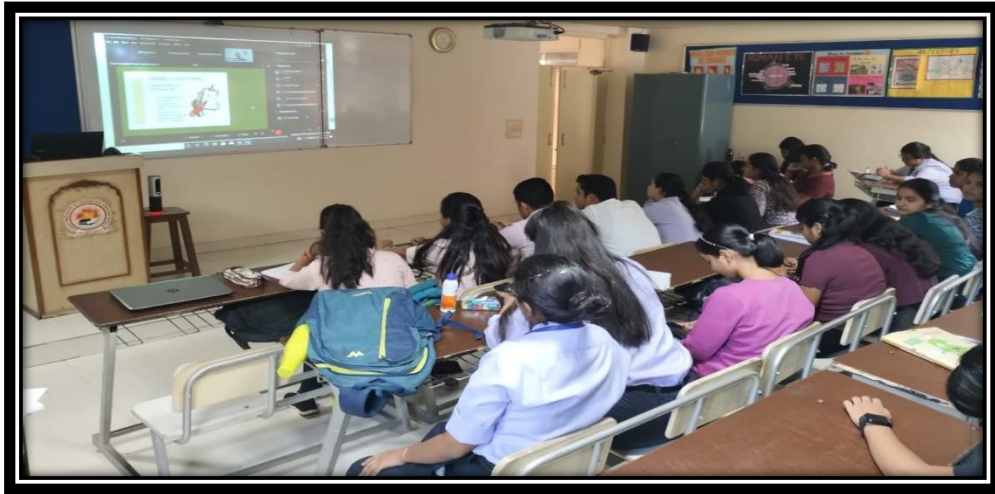
