### Under BED151 -UNDERSTANDING THE SELF : (5th December, 2023)

The Student Seminar under the Course Code- BED151(Understanding the Self) was organized in the Seminar Hall of the AIE, Greater Noida on Friday, 5<sup>th</sup> December,2023. The B.Ed. Students of first year (Batch-2023-25) participated in the seminar with great enthusiasm. For this event the students presented their work according to the groups allotted to them. #### CONTENT

They had to prepare a digital-story on any special-case, on any inspirational personality or any role-model of their choice showcasing different circumstances faced in their childhood and also their important childhood experiences.
