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Report on "Employability Skill Programme" Conducted by Mahindra Pride Classroom with Naandi Foundation on 23 Feb 2024

Introduction:

The Employability Skill Programme conducted by Mahindra Pride Classroom in collaboration with Naandi Foundation at the Army Institute of Education, Greater Noida, U.P., from 16th to 23rd February 2024 aimed to equip fifty-four participants with essential skills required for successful employment.

Objective:

The primary objective of the programme was to enhance the employability of participants by imparting crucial skills such as communication, problem-solving, teamwork, leadership, and adaptability.

The programme spanned over eight days, during which participants engaged in a variety of interactive sessions, workshops, and practical exercises. Each day was dedicated to a specific set of skills, with expert facilitators guiding participants through theoretical concepts and practical applications. The curriculum was designed to address the needs of various industries and job roles, ensuring relevance and applicability.

Learning out comes:
