Introduction

Essential tools and materials, such as spades, watering cans, and organic fertilizers, were distributed to ensure the success of the plantation.

The event saw enthusiastic participation from over 150 individuals, including students, faculty, staff, and local community members. Retired army personnel and their families also took part, reflecting the community's strong commitment to environmental initiatives. A total of 100 saplings were planted in and around the campus.
