Report on Voter Awareness Campaign NSS Cell, Army Institute of Education, Greater Noida

How do I vote in person?

- First polling official will check your name on the voter list and check your ID proof.
- Second polling official will link your finger, give you a slip and take your signature on a register (Form 17A).
- You will have to deposit the slip at the third polling official and show your inked finger and then proceed to the polling booth.
- Record your vote by pressing the ballot button opposite the symbol of the candidate of your choice on the Electronic Voting Machine (EVM); You will hear a beep sound.
- Check the slip that appears in the transparent window of the VVPAT machine. The slip with the Candidate serial No., Name and Symbol shall be visible for 7 seconds before it drops in the sealed VVPAT box.
- You can press NOTA, None of the Above, if you don't like any candidate; it's the last button on the EVM.

मैं व्यक्तिगत रूप से कैसे मतदान करूँ?

- पहले पहले मतदान अधिकारी मतदाता सूची में आपका नाम जांचेंगे और आपका आईडी चूक जांचेंगे।
- दूसरा मतदान अधिकारी आपकी उंगली पर रंगही लगाएंगे, आपको एक पर्ची द्या और एक रजिस्टर पर आपका हस्ताक्षर लेगा (फॉर्म 17A)।
- आपको तीसरे मतदान अधिकारी के पास पर्ची जमा करनी होगी और अपनी रंगही उंगली दिखानी होगी और फिर मतदान बॉक्स पर अपना मतदान दर्ज करे।
- इलेक्ट्रॉनिक वोटिंग मशीन (ईवीएम) पर अपनी पसंद के उम्मीदवार के प्रतीक के सामने मतदान बटन दबाएंगे जसका अर्थ रिकॉर्ड करे, आपको एक मिनट की अवधि प्राप्त होगी।
- सीटीईट मशीन की पारदर्शी खिंची में रिकॉर्ड देने वाली पर्ची की जांच करे। उम्मीदवार के नाम, नाम और प्रतीक वाली पर्ची सीटीईट मशीन के खिंचे में गिरने से पहले 7 सेकंड के लिए दिखाई देगी।
- यदि आपको कोई उम्मीदवार पसंद नहीं है तो आप NOTA, 'None of the Above' बटन दबा सकते हैं; यह बटन EVM का अंतिम बटन है; अधिक जानकारी के लिए कृपया ecisveep.nic.in पर मतदाता गाइड देखें।
