REPORT ON EXCURSION TO INDIA GATE AND WAR MEMORIAL

The Army Institute of Education, Greater Noida, organized an educational excursion to India Gate and the War Memorial in Delhi on 08.09.2024, led by Assistant Professors Dr. Jyoti Tiwari, Ms. Kriti Guleria, and Ms. Komal Chaudhary.
