Report of Think, Pair and Share Activity under the Innovate Pedagogical Strategies; Date: - 22 November 2024

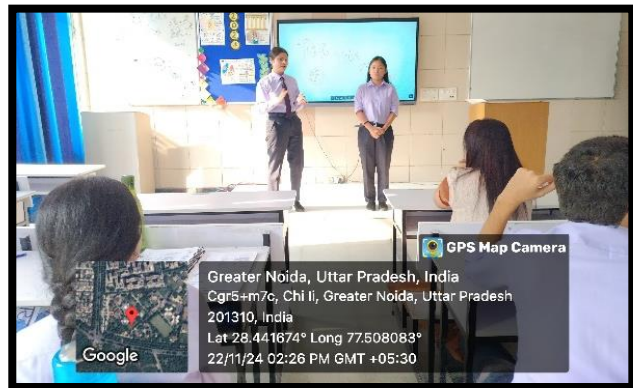
